Specifically, employees of the PETA organization appeared in a trailer park located near the Town of Parksley and proceeded to round up various animals including at least one belonging to a resident of the trailer park. The dog was removed from its owners' porch, there was a security camera video of the entire episode. The employees subsequently returned with a fruit basket as sort of a condolence for the euthanization of the family pet, Maya.

It is my understanding that VDACS is the regulatory agency for this type of activity carried out by PETA. I would hope and urge VDACS to use whatever regulatory authority it may have over the activities of PETA in this incident as certainly, I think, they are worthy of intense review and scrutiny.
