## Structure of a Stonecroft Talk

## CREATE AN EFFECTIVE OPENING OF INTEREST TO SECULAR WOMEN

An effective opening prepares the audience to want to listen to what you have to say.
The opening should gain the listeners' attention and establish rapport
with those who are not yet interested in spiritual things.
___ Use humor, a question, an illustration or a bold statement that relates to the content of your talk.

## ESTABLISH THE NEED IN YOUR LIFE

___ Illustrate attitudes or feelings about yourself that made you realize you had a need for Jesus Christ.
___ Identify needs/emotions that are common to human experience so that audience can identify those in themselves even though their circumstances may be different.

CLEARLY PRESENT HOW YOU CAME TO KNOW JESUS CHRIST
___ What were the circumstances?
___ What did you do to become a believer?

## PRESENT JESUS CHRIST

## __ Jesus Christ is God's Son

___ He died for our sins (which separate us from God) so we can be forgiven
___ He was buried and rose from the dead
___ Gives eternal life to all who receive Him and believe

## ILLUSTRATE WHAT GOD IS DOING IN YOUR LIFE.

___ Share what has changed within you since you invited Christ into our life.
__ How did God meet your previously stated needs?
___ How is God currently meeting your needs?
___ Support some of your illustrations with Scriptures, but be cautious of teaching or preaching.
___ Do not overly promote self or products such as books, music etc.

## CREATE A STRONG SUMMARY

___ Pull together your theme with application to the audience
___ Conclude with a challenge for the listener to take definite action to receive Christ.

## EXPLAIN HOW TO PERSONALLY RECEIVE JESUS CHRIST

___ Clearly state what a person must do to receive Christ.
___ Acknowledge those not ready to make a decision \& those who already believe.
___ Include appropriate Bible verses, but avoid lengthy passages.
___ Invite those who desire to accept Christ to pray a prayer of acceptance silently with you as you pray aloud.

## THEME

___ Is it clear?
___ Is it repeated throughout the talk in a consistent way?
