GENERAL INFORMATION

The Wildcat Classic will take place on Saturday, October 19, 2019 at Valencia High School. Valencia High School is located at 27801 N. Dickason Drive, Santa Clarita, CA, 91355, just minutes from Six Flags Magic Mountain. With extraordinarily tight budgets, our conveniently located venue provides a nearby performance opportunity for schools in Northern LA and Ventura Counties, the Santa Clarita, Antelope, San Gabriel, and San Fernando Valleys, as well as schools in Bakersfield and the rest of Southern California.

APPLICATION & ENTRY FEE

The registration application is due by Friday, September 27, 2019. An entry fee of \$325 per band is required with the registration application. Please make all registration checks payable to the West Ranch High School Band Boosters.

SCORING & AWARDS

Adjudication will be provided by the Southern California School Band and Orchestra Association. Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each division. Additionally, there will be awards for High Music, High Percussion, High Auxiliary, and Sweepstakes.

LOGISTICS

Participant packets will be sent out to all registered schools 1-2 weeks prior to the event. These packets will contain the final warm-up and performance schedules. We will also include detailed maps and aerial photos of the campus and surrounding areas so it will be easy to find your way around.

Ample bus and equipment trailer/truck parking is available and within close proximity to all warm-up areas and the stadium. Student Ambassadors will be assigned to each unit to guide bands to and from warm-up and performance areas. Wrist bands granting field entrance and back field seating privileges will be provided for all student performers and seven support personnel. Badges allowing front side seating and access to hospitality will be provided for all staff members and directors.

Our goal is to make sure you and your students have a wonderful experience.

CONCESSIONS & HOSPITALITY

There will be a number of local vendors providing an assortment of great food, drinks, and snacks for participants and spectators. Additionally, the West Ranch Band Boosters will provide food and drinks to help with our fundraising efforts. Your patronage is appreciated.
