

HELPFUL REMINDERS FOR A SUCCESSFUL SCHOOL YEAR

The beginning of the school year is a great time to remind students and parents about the general procedures followed at school each day. These will help ensure a successful day and year for children, families and teachers. Thank you for remembering to:

- Look through your child's bookbag and go over the items sent home each day with your child;
- · Help your child remember to return papers when they are due;
- · Help your child get to school each day on time;
- Call the absentee line at (708) 757 2115 option #1 before 8:30 a.m. each day your child will be absent;
- Send a note to the teacher when your child returns to school after an absence;
- Sign in at the office and wear a visitor's badge every time you are in the building;
- Deliver forgotten items to the office, not the classroom;
- Send a note in with your child is he/she is doing something different after school (for example riding the bus home with a friend or going to a friend's house). If you forget the note in the morning, call the school before 12:00 p.m. (noon) to ensure this information gets to the teacher and your student in time for dismissal. If you call after 12:00 p.m. (noon) we may not be able to honor your request;
- Come into the office to sign your student out during the day. The office will call down to the child's
 classroom and the student will be sent to the office to meet you. Students will not be released to a
 parent from the classroom by the teacher;
- If sending party invitations to school, send a invite to EVERY student in the classroom;
- Sign up for Class DoJo.
