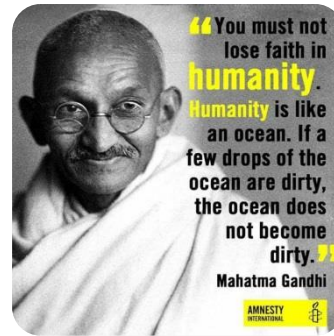
Message from the Principal

We will be hosting a general election in school for students on **7th June**. The students need to see the purpose of voting and be able to make an informed choice about who they will vote for.

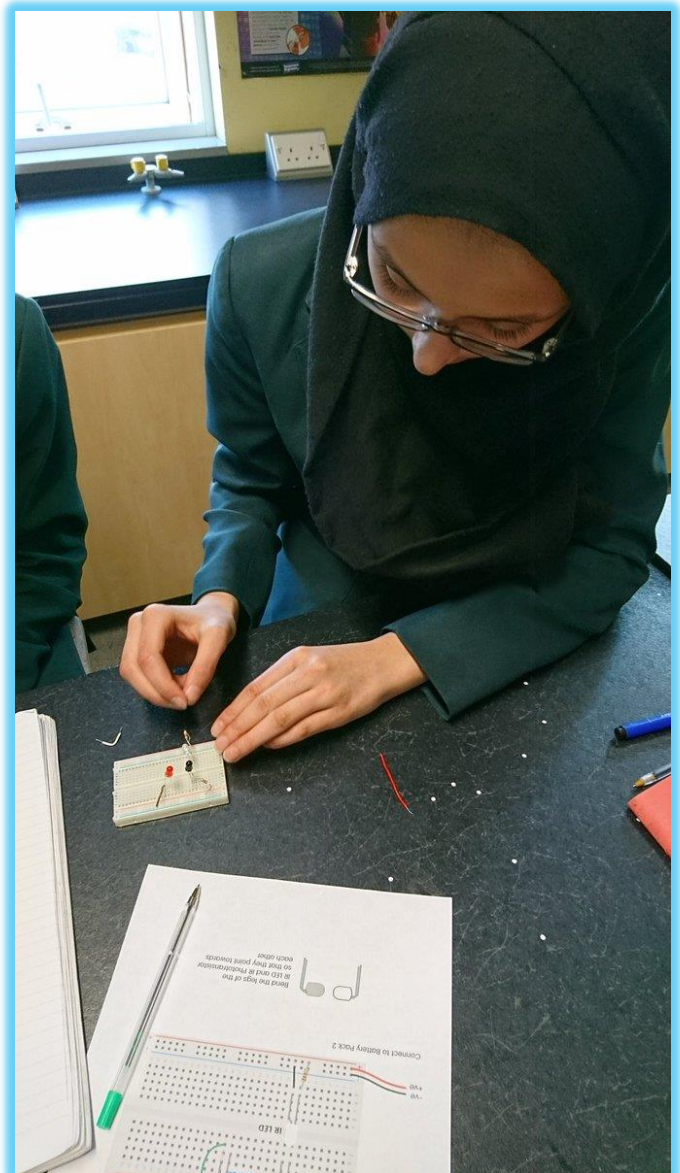
The turnout for Manchester Gorton at the last general election was just 57%. If the students are better informed, then hopefully they will have conversations with their parents which will encourage them to vote too.

Pattern Craft came to visit Cedar Mount Academy, they are a STEM computer programming project which links programming to the real world, firstly students created their own programming card which was automatically read by the Raspberry Pi Computer, and churned out a 3D image of their card using Minecraft technology (attached Raspberry Pi Pic), then students were also required to create a fire alarm using a "bread board" circuit board and wiring provided by pattern craft to create a working smoke detector.

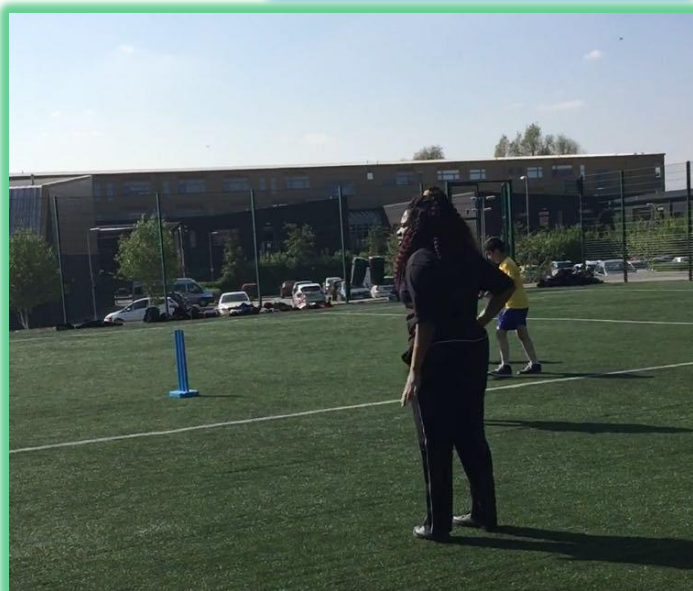
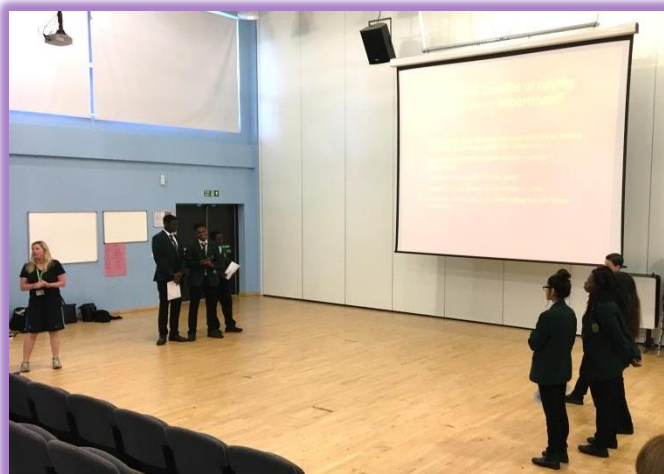

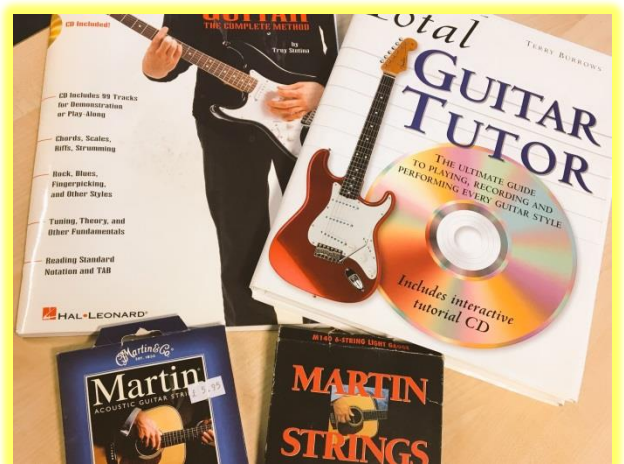
