How to Get There

BY AIR

Brisbane Airport is the gateway to South East Queensland. Direct flights operate from all Australian Capital cities and major regional centres.

Sunshine Coast Airport is located approximately 12 kilometres from Maroochydore. Qantas and Jetstar operate direct flights from Sydney while Jetstar operates direct flights from Melbourne and Adelaide.

Toowoomba, the gateway to Southern Queensland Country, is located 125km west of Brisbane and is easily accessed by Brisbane West Wellcamp Airport. QantasLink flies daily to Toowoomba from Sydney with connections from other capital cities.



1. The Beaches

There are so many sensational beaches along the coast. Families will love Mooloolaba and Caloundra, as well as Alexandra Headland. Noosa's Main Beach is the coast's premier beach destination, while locals savour the peace of Coolum and Marcoola beaches. The golden sands continue for kilometres on Fraser and Moreton islands and Brisbane has its very own beach at South Bank.

2. Fraser Island

Located along the southern coast of Queensland lies the exquisite World Heritage Listed Fraser Island. Swim in freshwater lakes and creeks, 4WD the beach highway and see 1000 year old rainforest growing from sand. The island is brimming with natural beauty. 3. Australia Zoo

Visit Australia Zoo, home of the Crocodile Hunter and some of Australia's most unique and amazing wildlife. Walk with a Sumatran tiger and get up close and personal with a crocodile. Enjoy the many wildlife shows. (see pages 17 and 36 for details)

4. Whale Watching

Enjoy the magnificent Humpback whales in their natural habitat. 5. Eumundi Markets

6. Sunshine Coast Hinterland

Escape to the country villages of Maleny, Montville and Mapleton. Enjoy a rainforest walk to the spectacular Kondalilla Falls.
