



#### **CHILD SUMMER SAFETY TIP**

Sometimes we attend large events during the summer months. Before taking children to these events, take a second, pull our your cell phone and take individual pictures of each child. That way, if the unthinkable happens and a child gets lost, you have a picture of how they are dressed and what they look like that day.



TAKE THE PICTURE! The photo can also be immediately sent to police to aid in locating the child. Seconds can be precious in this scenario. So, take a second, make it a habit and take the picture!
