





THE GOLDEN BOOT RACE



1. MOHAMED SALAH equals the record for consecutive Premier League Golden Boot wins (3).
2. Only three nations have more Premier League Golden Boot wins than Egypt (**England, France, Netherlands**).
3. HARRY KANE is now the joint-10th top scorer in Premier League history (**149**).
4. PIERRE-EMERICK AUBAMEYANG is the first Arsenal player to score **20+ Premier League goals** in consecutive seasons since Thierry Henry (2004/05, 2005/06).
5. SERGIO AGUERO has now scored more hat tricks (**13**) than any player in Premier League history, surpassing ALAN SHEARER.
6. JAMIE VARDY'S 10 strikes takes his career total to **90 Premier League goals**, surpassing CRISTIANO RONALDO (**84**) and DENNIS BERGKAMP (**87**).

3. **MESUT OZIL** breaks into the top 20 assist-providers in Premier League history by **GAMEWEEK 16**, overtaking **ERIC CANTONA (56)**, **PAUL SCHOLES (55)**, **EDEN HAZARD (54)** and **ROBIN VAN PERSIE (53)** on the way.
4. **ALEX IWOBI** records as many Premier League assists in 2019/20 as his uncle **JAY-JAY OKOCHA** managed in his entire career.
5. **DAVID SILVA** equals **STEVEN GERRARD'S** tally of 92 Premier League assists (sixth in the all-time ranking).
6. **BERNARDO SILVA**, **JOAO MOUTINHO** and **MESUT OZIL** recorded the longest streak of assists in consecutive games (**4**) in 2019/20.






1. ALISSON and EDERSON are the first goalkeepers to record **20+ Premier League clean sheets** in consecutive seasons.
2. ALISSON helps Liverpool up to third in the all-time Premier League rankings for clean sheets (414).
3. Burnley equal their club record for clean sheets in a single Premier League season.
4. KASPER SCHMEICHEL is the only 'keeper outside the 'Big Six' to avoid conceding at Anfield in over two years.
5. DAVID SEAMAN (4) and PAUL ROBINSON (5) are now the only 'keepers with more Premier League assists than EDERSON (3).


HOW THE TITLE RACE UNFOLDED



1. This is the first time Chelsea have failed to win the Premier League after topping the table at Christmas.
2. 'The Blues' **seven-match winless streak** from GAMEWEEK 22 to 28 is the longest such run of any top-six team all season.
3. Back-to-back runners up Liverpool have not spent a single week outside the Premier League top three for two years.
4. Only five different teams ever occupy first place: Brighton, Chelsea, Liverpool, Man City and Man Utd.
5. PEP GUARDIOLA has achieved three of the **top five single season points totals in Premier League history.**



THE RELEGATION BATTLE



1. Across the whole division, Aston Villa collected the highest proportion of their points away from home (**49%**).
2. Brighton were the only team to spend a gameweek in both first and last place over the 2019/20 Premier League season.
3. Only four teams have scored fewer than Burnley's **31 goal total** in a Premier League season and avoided relegation.
4. Newcastle won nine points from games vs 'Big Six' teams, more than third-placed Spurs and fourth-placed Chelsea (**both 8**).
5. Norwich have been relegated more times than any team in Premier League history.
6. All of Sheffield Utd's **last three Premier League campaigns** have ended in relegation.

EXT. KEN FRIAR BRIDGE

STARTING IN REVERSE (GAMEWEEK 1-5)

The Emirates expects progress. But things get ugly in a hurry as Arsenal lose **THREE OF THEIR FIVE OPENING Premier League games**. The first North London Derby ends 2-2. They drop to FIFTEENTH. Just below Sheffield Utd.

SAME OLD ARSENAL? (GW 6-18)

The EUROPA LEAGUE campaign begins with a shock loss to pile on the pressure. But Arsenal rally in classic fashion. PIERRE-EMERICK AUBAMEYANG smashes **four** past Aston Villa. The Gunners are on a 10-match unbeaten run at home and abroad.

Third Arsenal player to score four Premier League goals in a single game (1st Henry, 2nd Arshavin)

But all good things must end. Southampton and Man City win at the Emirates to once again sour the mood. A **BAFFLING 4-4** draw against West Ham best sums up the chaos that is UNAI EMERY'S Arsenal. Meanwhile, they top their EUROPA LEAGUE group.

CONSISTENTLY INCONSISTENT (GW 19-32)

Arsenal complete a rare double by **beating Man Utd at home on New Year's Day**. Murder on the dancefloor. AUBAMEYANG is the star attraction again. He is a man on a mission to power Arsenal into the top four.


But as a team the Gunners veer between awesome and atrocious. They edge past PSV in Europe. Back at home Everton win at the Emirates, leading to another chorus of boos. Man City smash them 3-0. They are relieved it is not more.

LITTLE PROGRESS, MUCH PAIN (GW 33-38)

It seems only the Europa League can save them. They draw Man Utd. Arsenal **abandon all hope and CRASH OUT 3-2**. Just as they feared. Fans are more sad than angry. Once again they rally. AUBAMEYANG and ALEXANDRE LACAZETTE lead a DEMOLITION of high flying Liverpool. But they drop too many points and end up trophyless with another fifth-place finish.





A HARD RAIN'S A-GONNA FALL (GAMEWEEK 1-15)

Aston Villa are back in the big time and everyone is EXCITED to see what they can do. We are all disappointed when Villa win just THREE TIMES in their opening 15 games.

WESLEY starts strongly. A 2-1 win vs. Bournemouth in GAMEWEEK 2 lifts JACK GREATISH'S Premier League curse. But Villa become 'Big Six' punching bags and drop down the table like a stone. JOTA delivers their first win against Man Utd for 10 YEARS. But even that cannot keep them off the BOTTOM OF THE LEAGUE.

THINGS CAN ONLY GET BETTER (GW 16-20)

Villa's poor run creates doubters. But DEAN SMITH shrugs off the talk and Villa WIN THREE OF THEIR NEXT FIVE. They are out of the relegation zone as the year comes to a close. Optimism grows.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN (GW 21-33)

Villa begin 2020 in superb away form. They win three of their first four games on the road. This includes a huge 1-4 win vs. Southampton, their biggest against the Saints since 1999.

The travelling fans begin to generate an incredible atmosphere. Villa do not lose away from Villa Park for SIX GAMES until Liverpool THRASH THEM at Anfield in April.


HOME SWEET HOME (GW 34-38)

After picking up nearly half their points on the road VILLA WIN THEIR FINAL TWO HOME GAMES. The HOLTE END FAITHFUL are finally rewarded for their loyalty with their first Premier League win over Arsenal since 1998.


49% of Villa's points in 19/20 were won away from home. The highest percentage in the league

ASTON VILLA

The three points lifts them up to **12th**. A final day away defeat knocks them back to **15th**. VILLA SURVIVE their first season back in the big time with their best finish since 2012/13.



1. Aston Villa did not win consecutive games at home until their very last two home games of the season.
2. Villa spent as many GAMEWEEKS at the bottom of the Premier League table as Sheffield Utd, who finished **20th**.
3. Jack Grealish and Matt Targett (**both 7**) record the joint-most assists of any promoted players.

SLOPPY START (GAMEWEEK 1-11)

Bournemouth are used to competing with the big boys by now. They are in their fifth season as a top-flight team. New boys Sheffield Utd are used to reminding everyone of this: 4-1 at Dean Court. **No team outscores them on GAMEWEEK one.** The TOP-10 is there to be cracked.

But there is always a bigger fish in the Premier League. Man City put five past them without reply. Arsenal hit three. Watford help themselves to a hatful. Man Utd claim four. The Cherries' porous defence is **well off the pace.** Bournemouth sit **13th** and enter November with the **WORST DEFENCE IN THE DIVISION.**

Bournemouth kept the joint fewest clean sheets in the division (with Norwich)

BACK ON TRACK (GW 12-18)

Creditable victories over Newcastle and Wolves are secured. Bournemouth move up to **9th**. They get no change off the 'Big Six' during a difficult December. Liverpool, Chelsea and Arsenal all put the Cherries to the sword. But **JOSH KING echoes OLE GUNNAR SOLSKJAER** to earn his team three points vs. Burnley.

NO FLAT-TRACK BULLIES (19-33)

A top-half finish is still there for them in the new year. But opportunities to build are wasted. Points are dropped against Brighton, Norwich, Aston Villa and Burnley. The type of teams that should by now be easy work.




Safety. But nothing more. HOWE'S dashed hopes of a top-half finish send Bournemouth back to the drawing board.

SYSTEM SHOCK (GAMEWEEK 1-3)


Brighton scored fewer Premier League goals than any team to avoid the drop last year. GRAHAM POTTER is a more attack-minded manager and it instantly shows. A new club record is set by full time on his competitive debut: Watford 0-4 Brighton. **Their biggest Premier League win ever.** Enough goals to go top of the table. Narrow wins vs. West Ham and Southampton follow. **Six goals and none conceded by GAMEWEEK3.** Europa League chatter rings out around the South Coast.

OFF A CLIFF (GW 4-17)

Man City derail the Seagulls' hype train. Back-to-back stalemates against Burnley and Newcastle are brushed off by fans. But a confidence crisis develops. The steepest slide of ANY TEAM ALL SEASON sets in.

FOURTEEN GAMES WITHOUT A WIN sees Brighton plummet. Seven defeats on the spin. Spurs and Man Utd fill their boots. So do Crystal Palace. POTTER feels the pressure.

TOP TO BOTTOM FORM (GW1-16)



Brighton scored just 5 goals, - and conceded 30 during this time

Only Burnley (31) scored fewer league goals than Brighton (33) in 19/20

BACK FROM THE BRINK? (GAMEWEEK 18-23)

The 119-DAY wait for a win FINALLY ends after a six-pointer at Sheffield Utd. Brighton climb off the bottom in time for Christmas. The festive joy is short lived. Defeat to Spurs puts them back there five days later.

Nothing has changed by mid-January. The lack of goals within the side is painfully obvious. A 36-YEAR-OLD GLENN MURRAY remains the biggest threat.

JUST ABOUT ENOUGH (GW 24-38)


FOUR WINS IN A ROW against Bournemouth, West Ham, Watford and Sheffield Utd go down a treat. Eight points clear and almost out of the woods.

Defeat at home to rivals Palace triggers another slump of four straight defeats. The safety cushion is cut to two. But Man Utd promptly fail to break their Amex curse.


Wins over fellow strugglers Norwich and Newcastle bring up the magical 40-POINT MARK just in time. Survival ticks a box but the jury is still out on last May's managerial change.

EARLY PROMISE (GAMEWEEK 1-3)

Burnley start out as underdogs again. SEAN DYCHE is happy with that. EVERYBODY knows what they are going to get against his side. Few know how to combat it. SOUTHAMPTON are the first victims at Turf Moor. Burnley even win ON THE ROAD against WOLVES. Everyone expects another big season. **So much for being underdogs.**

Burnley score 5 goals in a Premier League game for the first time ever

BAD HABITS (GW 4-17)

Liverpool come to Turf Moor and win 0-3. It smashes Burnley's CONFIDENCE. Eight games they go without a win, including two more home defeats. Things start to look hairy.

Burnley finally remember their shooting boots and **THUMP West Ham.** But as Christmas approaches they are only two points clear of danger.

The 38 fixtures involving Burnley saw only 82 goals - at least 9 fewer than any other team

DIRE STRAITS (GW 18-32)

The festive period brings nothing but misery. **A trademark 1-0 win** over Leicester is the only highlight.

After that Burnley win **just ONCE in THREE months.** A staggering run of form that plunges them TO THE BOTTOM OF THE TABLE. The vultures are circling around the manager and everyone expects Burnley to be relegated.

Poor form precedes CHRISTMAS: **just one win in five**. Chelsea inflict Southampton's **worst defeat** of the season on BOXING DAY. Southampton regroup. They start 2020 with just **two defeats in 11 games**. A key win vs. Newcastle lifts the Saints up to **11th**. It is the highest they will be all season.


SAVED (GW 30-38)







TROY DEENEY shows up against Man Utd as Watford win. Struggling Sheffield Utd beat the Hornets 1-0 on Boxing Day.

FALSE DAWN (GW 20-29)

Watford are FIRMLY mid-table. Even when they move up to 8th they do so without any form behind them. JAVI GRACIA speaks positively but fans are cynical. They can sense the fall.

Finally some consistency, as Watford put four consecutive results together for the first time all season. The problem is they are defeats. Four losses on the bounce turns February into a NIGHTMARE MONTH. They drop to 14th. Yet another post-Christmas collapse feels inevitable.

THE MIDDLE GROUND (GW 30-38)





The front four begin to click. A FELIPE ANDERSON masterclass sees West Ham beat Leicester City **3-1**. FORNALS, HALLER and MANUEL LANZINI trade flicks and tricks as the Hammers repeat the scoreline vs. Bournemouth. They climb above Watford and Wolves into ninth. The battle to be best of the rest is on.

2020 BRINGS MORE OF THE SAME (GW 22-31)


West Ham lose to 19TH PLACE Sheffield Utd 11 days into the new year. **CONSECUTIVE HOME LOSSES** to Everton and Brighton follow. BEATING THE BLUES (GW 32-38)



What was mild concern snowballs. By GAMEWEEK 13 MOLINEUX has witnessed just one home win. **Wolves are 18th**. Their first GAMEWEEK spent in the relegation zone since their top-flight return. To a side seeking to gatecrash the top six it is a grave reminder: **survival is not guaranteed**.

CHRISTMAS COMES EARLY (GW 14-18)

FOUR STRAIGHT WINS to start December lift Wolves out of danger and into EIGHTH PLACE. It is their first such top-flight run since 1971/72. Man City complete a HUMILIATING double on Boxing Day. In their next two games Liverpool beat them and Watford hold them. Wolves fall to 11th as 2020 begins. But no Premier League team punches above its weight like they do. Liverpool learn this via defeat in the return at Molineux. A first win at Old Trafford in three decades follows. **JIMENEZ'S goalscoring form makes club history**. Malmo are dispatched in Europe as **Wolves make the Last 16** of a UEFA competition for the first time since 1972, when they reached the final.

HISTORY REPEATED (UEFA EUROPA LEAGUE LAST 16)

Tottenham won the inaugural UEFA CUP nearly half a century ago by beating Wolves in the showpiece match. This time they meet in an earlier round. The outcome is the same: Spurs win, progressing 6-2 on aggregate.

Surpasses Fletcher to become Wolves' all-time PL top scorer (28 goals)

Domestic affairs represent a silver lining. Consecutive wins lifts Wolves to 17th as we enter April. They can almost touch the top six.



IT IS TOO EASY (THE KNOCKOUTS)

In the ROUND OF 16 Bayern shock Atletico Madrid by winning in Spain. No team had ever beaten DIEGO SIMEONE at home in UEFA Champions League knockout football. The return in Bavaria is tense but **ROBERT LEWANDOWSKI** settles it late on.

Now the 5th highest goal scorer in UCL history (59 goals)

Bayern make light work of PSG in the QUARTER-FINALS. There they face the old enemy, Juventus. They walk to a win in Turin and then do the same at home. It is their **13th victory** in semis, A NEW RECORD.

UEFA CHAMPIONS LEAGUE CLASSIC (THE FINAL)







NEW FACTORS SET TO TEAR UP THIS SCRIPT

The best laid plans of mice and men often go awry.

Our script is based upon a predictive model's simulation of the upcoming campaign. Years of data are analysed and distilled into an assessment of the strengths of all 20 Premier League teams.

But English top-flight football is entering a brand new era for 2019/20. This is the first ever season in which there will be a '**mid-season player break**'. In February, one gameweek will be split across two weekends and all clubs will have a 10-day rest period. Ten teams play one week; the remainder play the other.

The potential ramifications are significant. The festive fixture list is manic in this country. Former Manchester United manager Louis van Gaal once called it "the most evil thing" about English football. Allowing for a rest period could give teams a chance to transform fitness plans and even lower injury rates.

It may also impact intangibles such as 'momentum'. Those who were playing well could suddenly run out of steam; strugglers might find rhythm. No model can legislate for something that did not exist before.

Similarly, **VAR will finally be introduced** in the Premier League. We have already witnessed the massive effect this technology has had at the 2018 and 2019 World Cups. The number of penalties awarded surged in those competitions (it went from 13 awarded in 2014 to 29 awarded in 2018 - a 123% increase) as referees were now able to better scrutinise infractions in the box. Will this happen in the Premier League? How will that change or alter results?

Then there are **injuries, sackings, new signings and departures**. These are not new to English football but are true wildcards for any forecast. You never know when a player's hamstring will tear and how that may impact a season. The same can be said for managerial changes, which usually punctuate awful runs of form.

Our script lays out a compelling story of an incredible season. But every script, no matter how well researched, structured and plotted is subject to the slings and arrows of outrageous fortune.

THE METHODOLOGY OF THE SCRIPT

BT has brought together the biggest brains in sports data, analysis and machine learning to write an artificial intelligence (AI) driven script for the 2019/20 Premier League season.

Leading data scientists, in partnership with Squawka, have analysed the world's foremost football data from Opta and hosted on Google Cloud Platform.

Using machine learning* (ML), the system calculated the relative strengths of each team rating attacking strength (goals) and defensive solidity (goals conceded) based on historic data from thousands of matches over previous seasons.

It then worked out the probability of every conceivable scoreline for all future games - home and away - as well as goalscorers and assist makers.

Random events that could occur during a season - such as injuries and player transfers - were simulated to give an even more accurate set of predictions.

Finally, the data was brought to life in an action-packed script - telling the story of the season for every team, adding data visualisation to dramatise the key stats.

THE NEXT CHAPTER

As the season progresses, BT will continue to work with the data and ML technology to take the model to the next level.

Google Cloud Composer, a fully managed data orchestration platform, will be used to ingest a real-time data feed from Opta - pulling in live football data as it happens straight into Google Cloud's serverless data warehouse, BigQuery, where it will be analysed and enriched.

Next up, AI Platform Notebooks, a fully managed JupyterLab environment, are used to explore the data and defines the parameters for the next-generation predictive model based on the popular XGBoost library.

Finally, AI Platform Training will be used to train the model on the entire dataset and made available through AI Platform Prediction for providing real time insights.

And it will never stop learning.
