All the instruction you need to make the units required for the base unit of this block can be found on the [Shaded Nine Patch Technique](#) sheet. The instructions you need to make the Corner Pops on the base shapes came with your [Corner Pop®](#) tool. There are charts, step by step graphics, and directions. Use the chart to find the information you need for the finished size of the unit you want to make. Then work your way through the instructions.

When making the four Shaded Nine Patch units you will need to use two different fabrics for the rectangle that you add to your pieced section. This gives you two Shaded Nine Patch units with one color for the triangle and two Shaded Nine Patch units with a second color. This will allow you to alternate the colors in the center of the block from one unit to the next. The fabric that you use for the rectangles will also be used for your Corner Pops®. Make sure that you use the opposite fabric when you're popping your corners.

In step 6 of the technique sheet, when you are pressing, press the two units with the same triangle fabric as described and press the other two toward the pieced triangle section of the unit. Press the seams of your Corner Pops® in the same direction as the seam of your Shaded Nine Patch unit. By pressing the seams this way it will allow your seams to nest when you sew your units together. When you sew your four Shaded Nine Patch units together press those seams open to help distribute the bulk.
