Dear Parent and/or Spectator,

We are excited you are attending CHEERSPORT 2021 National Cheerleading Championship!

We always appreciate your support and that is especially true this year! We are humbled by the effort and dedication it took to get you and your athlete to Atlanta. Our event will look different this year due to the changes necessary to conduct a live event. Just like you, we have had to adapt to today's environment. Your gym owner/ coach will be providing meeting times and other information. Please adhere to those requests. Do not arrive early or attempt to linger after performances. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Please read through the attached information carefully. Even if you are a CHEERSPORT Nationals veteran, things are different. For example, the CNN food court is closed as well as some other nearby restaurants. You will still have a great time, it may just require a little more planning.

One more thing. Even under the best of circumstances, having a child compete in all star cheer is challenging. The last year certainly has not been the best of circumstances. However, you have done what has been necessary to keep your child engaged with the sport they love. Our theme with the Coaches/Owners this year is "You Have Already Won". The point being just getting to Nationals was worth celebrating. We would say the same to you, by supporting your athlete and just getting to Nationals, You Too Have Already Won!

HOW CAN I PLAN?

This year will be different, even before you arrive to the event. Please plan for longer lines at hotel elevators and limited capacity at restaurants. The Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau (ACVB) has put together a website, for CHEERSPORT attendees that includes open restaurants and attractions. Click here to discover Atlanta!

IS THE CNN CENTER OPEN?

No, the CNN Center is closed. There will be limited concessions offered at the GWCC. The ACVB has put together a website, for CHEERSPORT attendees that includes open restaurants and attractions. Click here to discover Atlanta!

WHERE IS THE ENTRANCE TO THE EVENT?

NEW - Everyone will enter from the C Building of the GWCC, the North Side Drive entrance. If you are walking, you will pass the entrance into A and B Buildings before being able to enter into C Building. There are several parking decks around the C Building, click here to pre-purchase parking.

CAN I GET WRISTBANDS ON FRIDAY?

Yes. Admissions is located in C4 (North Side Drive entrance). Admissions is open Friday from 1pm-8pm, Saturday and Sunday all day starting at 7am. **Spectators are immediate family members of the athlete.** Spectator admission is \$10/day. We encouraged you purchase online via Eventbrite, click here to purchase tickets. *Online purchasers are still required to exchange their electronic ticket for a wristband at Admissions.*

WHEN SHOULD MY ATHLETES ARRIVE?

Due to capacity limits, please do not enter the C building more than 1 hour and 15 minutes before their performance time.

WHAT IS THE SPECTATOR HALL?

The Spectator Hall (C4) is the waiting area before you enter the Competition Arenas. Admissions and concessions are located in this Hall.

WILL SEATING BE AVAILABLE?

Due to capacity limits, seating will only be available in C4, the Spectator Hall. Seating will not be available in the competition arenas.

CAN I WATCH MULTIPLE TEAMS?

Spectators may only watch their athletes performance. Following the performance, spectators and their athletes will exit the building via the B building side. Please note that SPECTATORS are identified as immediate family members of the athletes on stage. CHEERSPORT will have staff and security enforcing this requirement. Our focus is:

- For athletes to compete in a live environment.
- Family members are able to watch the performance.
- Exit the building immediately following the performance.

ARE MASKS REQUIRED IN THE VENUE?

Masks are required for everyone in the building. Athletes may remove their masks during the active warmup and performance only. Coaches must wear their masks at all times. Spectators must wear masks at all times. If spectators are not able to wear a mask, they can watch the event via Varsity.TV.

MEETING ROOMS

Meetings rooms will not be offered for the 2021 CHEERSPORT National Championship.

WILL ATHLETES BE ALLOWED TO BRING WATER BOTTLES INTO THE VENUE?

The facility will have all water fountains turned off in the building. Athletes will be allowed to bring water bottles with them. However, they will not be able to refill their water bottles.

WILL THERE BE A BAG DROP AREA FOR ATHLETES?

Yes. Athletes that have their bags with them will need to carry them throughout the warm-up process and they will be able to drop them off on a cart before their performance. Our staff will move the cart to the exit side of the stage so that they can reclaim their bag as they exit.

ATLANTA IS A FOODIE CITY

I HAVE HEARD THAT SPECTATOR VIEWING WILL BE IN ROTATIONS. WHAT DOES THAT MEAN?

Yes. Spectators will enter arenas together with other spectators from their team. Spectators will rotate in and out of the arena. It will look similar to a "drive thru-fast food restaurant." All spectators will enter the halls thru C4. Spectators will spread out in C4. In C4, we will offer admissions, concessions and bathroom access. It is imperative that spectators know what arena and time that their team is scheduled to perform. All arenas will have a holding area located in C4. Approximately 30 minutes before the performance time, spectators will enter a holding area for their team. Arenas will be released in a staggered manner to spread out spectators along the walkway. If spectators are late, they will miss their holding time and will not be able to access the competition halls.

As spectators arrive to their respective hall, CHEER-SPORT staff and security will put them in their respective holding areas and guide them through each arena. Following the teams performance, spectators will move out of the viewing area- wait for their athlete and immediately exit via the B3/B2 or B2/B1 escalators. Spectators will not be allowed to walk to other arenas following their performance. Please note that there are no chairs in the competition arenas. Spectators need to be prepared to stand and walk approximately 45 minutes once they leave the holding area in C4.

WHAT IF I HAVE A CROSSOVER ATHLETE OR ATHLETE ON MULTIPLE TEAMS?

After each performance, spectators will be required to exit via the B building. Spectators will exit to the top of the B building and turn right to return to the C building. This is approximately a 30 minute walk. They may reenter the queue in C4 and start the process over. If the crossover performances are within an hour of each other, they will likely miss one of the performances.

HOW WILL AWARD CEREMONIES BE HANDLED?

Award ceremonies for CHEERSPORT Nationals will be virtual on the CHEERSPORT Facebook page. All national champion teams will receive their awards in the mail, following the event. Awards will be mailed to the address attached to the registration. It is important that coaches fill out the correct size for their athletes as CHEERSPORT will not be able to substitute and replace sizes via US mail. We anticipate giving athletes their CHEERSPORT blankets as they exit the stage on Saturday. Athletes will receive their medals when they exit the stage on Sunday. Blankets and medals will not be replaced if lost or forgotten at the stage.

Finally, please follow the guidelines and procedures we have outlined for you. We have an outstanding plan for hosting this event live but our planning will fail without your cooperation. Things like having people arrive early or finding a place to "hang out" together so we can watch the awards video may not seem to be a big issue but they are. Our plan assumes you are going to cooperate. If you don't, we run the risk of having the event shut down by government authorities who we cannot control. These are unusual times, please work with us. We are working diligently to ensure everyone has a great experience but that can only happen with your help!

We are thrilled you are going to be a part of CHEER-SPORT Nationals 2021. It is going to be fantastic and we can't wait to see you!

NEW - BUILDING C - ENTRANCE

• Building C, Level 1 is the Entrance to CHEERSPORT Nationals 2021. Please see the parking map for the closest parking decks. All spectators and athletes will Exit from Building B.

SPECTATOR HALL (C4)

• Building C, Level 1 Hall C4 has been designated as the spectator waiting area. We want to provide everyone enough space to maintain social distance. We request that all spectators arrive no more than 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to their teams performance time. Spectators will begin the process to enter all competition halls in C4, thirty minutes before the competition time. Please follow the signs accordingly.

SPECTATOR VIEWING

- Spectator viewing will be done by team only.
- Spectators will have a designated entry and exit traffic flow and will not be allowed into the competition arenas until thirty minutes before your scheduled performance time.
- The viewing area will be done on a rotation basis with physical distancing protocols in place.
- All spectators will follow the flow of traffic to meet up with their athletes as they leave the facility following each team performance.
- A general schedule listing the divisions and times for each performance is posted on the event page.

HEALTH INFORMATION

- Masks are mandatory for everyone two and over. Security will be stationed at each building entrance to ensure all entrants wear masks. Plastic face shields are not considered masks and may only be worn in addition to a mask.
- Should someone have a condition that precludes them from wearing a mask, they will not be allowed into the venue.
- We are advising anyone over the age of 65; anyone (of any age) with an underlying health condition or a compromised immune system; or anyone who has any specific concerns about COVID-19 exposure to not attend.
- Any spectator with any symptoms (Fever of 100°F or higher, cough, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea) may not enter.

WARM-UP ARENA

Parents are NOT allowed into the Warm-up Arena. Make sure you and your coach have a direct meeting place for the weekend!

Athletes will receive one gift as they exit the competition stage on Saturday ONLY.




Event Map need-to-know information

Teams should arrive to C-Lobby 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to their performance time. Teams can enter the building and move to the staging area into the Warm-Up Arena at this time.

NO stopping or sitting in the C-Lobby.


Spectators should not enter the building more than 1 hour and 30 minutes prior to their athletes performance time. Spectators should go directly to the Spectator Hall (C4) and wait here until their team is called. The entrance into all of the Competition Arenas is located in C4. Spectators and athletes will exit the Competition Arenas from B-Building Level 1 and proceed to Level 4.

WARM-UP ARENA:

Building C, Level 1 Halls C1/C2 (COACHES & ATHLETES ONLY)



CHEERSPORT EXIT:

All Competition Arenas will exit out of Building B, Level 1 up to Level 4



Event Concessions & Vendor Merchandise

- Concessions will be available for purchase with physical distancing protocols in place. Please note transactions may be limited to credit card only.
- There will be no tables or seating available. Congregating in the common area of the venue is not allowed.
- You may remove your mask to eat or drink, but must replace it immediately.
- Event merchandise will be available for purchase with physical distancing protocols in place. Please note transactions may be limited to credit card only.

Health Information

Varsity Spirit's baseline safety standards for include:

- Physical distancing protocols will be in place and enforced.
- Increased sanitization measures throughout venues, including enhanced cleaning protocols, hand sanitization stations and more frequent cleaning of performance surfaces.
- Increased physical distancing throughout the practice and performance areas.
- Adults and children two and older will be required to wear masks. Plastic face shields are not considered masks and may only be worn in addition to a mask.
- All attendees (including coaches, athletes, spectators, and Varsity Spirit staff) will be asked to monitor their own health prior to attending an event and follow the CDC guidelines for protecting themselves and others.
