

Trash to Treasure Competition Guidelines 2021

To mark the importance of Earth Day, United Way Mumbai has organized a Trash to Treasure competition under the aegis of Mission Mangroves for all interested candidate.

Candidates may take every day discarded or recycled material and re-engineer it into some artwork that is usable & functional. Some supporting materials might be used as fabric, paper, small electronics, springs, batteries, hardware, string, rubber bands, cardboard, kitchen gadgets, etc. in the designs.

Participation Criteria: -

- Junior Group: - 10 to 17 years.
- Senior Group: - 18 years and above.
- Only Individual entries are allowed. One entry per person.
- All artwork must be the sole creation of the individual(s) submitting the work.
- All artwork must have at least a good portion of it that is created out of recycled materials.
- Any photos that are unclear & do not match what the artwork looks like in real are subject to disqualification.
- Any fresh plastic item should not be used for the artwork (only old plastic/used material needs to be used to create your best out of waste entry).
- Evaluation will be based on artistic presentation and the effectiveness of the message conveyed. The decision of the juries will be the final decision and cannot be challenged.
- The selected candidates will be called to showcase their artwork and describe the process of making and its utility in the presence of the judges.

Note: - School students who don't have access to email may use their parent's email to register.
