Make sure you text ADVENTURELANDDAY to 555888 before the start of the treasure hunt on March 1 if you haven't already.
Familiarize yourself with the decoder and bird's stories attached.
Wait for a text message when the treasure hunt begins that will provide instructions.

DECODER

You will be texted clues to 6 points in the park by the three Tiki Room Birds to observe and count things, use those numbers in the decoder below.

EXAMPLE CLUE THAT WILL BE TEXTED AT START OF HUNT SUNDAY MARCH 1:

Pierre: How many entrances does the Castle have that point to Main Street?

Answer: 1, then look to see that 1 decodes to Word #184, so go to the 184th word in Pierre's story and write down that its the word "NEW" When you get all 6 words, it should point you to a treasure spot in the park to collect your treasure and help Jose find his way out of the lost forbidden temple!

Pierre, Fritz, and Michael will text you 2 clues each! Be sure to count from the words from the bird's story who texted the clue!
