BACK TO BASICS: SERVING OTHERS

Fr Damian's series of homilies on the basics of the Christian spiritual life continues this week on the theme of service. Jesus told us that all God's laws can be summed up by saying "Love God and love your neighbour as yourself". So just as we go to Mass, read the Bible and pray to deepen our love for God, we also have to love our neighbours too.

Jesus also said "love one another as I have loved you". The Lord showed his love for us through service — healing the sick, forgiving sinners, feeding the hungry, and taking time to listen to others. He also challenged those in authority who allowed unjust situations to continue. That's the sort of love Christians have to show. We must be willing to serve others and put their needs first. We should also care about the bigger problems facing the world — war, famine, environmental damage, abortion and disrespect for human dignity. These issues are spiritual as well as practical.

Begins on Ash Wednesday – 26th February

PARISH LENTEN COURSE: NO GREATER LOVE

What are you doing for Lent this year? Why not travel with Jesus as he enters into his passion? *No Greater Love* is a Lenten programme based around a series of short films shot on location in the Holy Land. Over five weeks we are given the opportunity to walk step-by-step with Jesus through the scriptures from the garden of Gethsemane to Mount Calvary. The short films are presented by Edward Sri who leads us on a biblical pilgrimage that reveals Christ's amazing love for us. At each session there will be the opportunity to pray and talk together as members of our Parish Family. There are 5 weekly sessions which begin on Wednesday 4th March in the parish hall at 7.30pm.

DOWN & CONNOR LOURDES PILGRIMAGE 2020

Each July Bishop Treanor leads the diocesan pilgrimage to Our Lady's shrine in Lourdes. It includes the celebration of Masses (including at the Grotto where St Bernadette saw Our Lady); celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick and Confession; participation in the Blessed Sacrament and Candlelight processions and the Way of the Cross. There is also plenty of free time for your own personal prayer, to relax, and to explore the town of Lourdes.
