### **Terms and Conditions**

- The bursaries shall be decided by a draw.
- Applicant/Student must be a member of PSCU at 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
- This bursary is only in respect of students who are first time entrants to third level education (i.e. first year students).
- Applicants are open to members on behalf of themselves or their children if a full time third level course is being pursued.
- Applications are limited to one per student.
- Evidence of acceptance at third level plus a copy of fee payment must be provided with the application form.
- Payment of the bursary in respect of 2nd and 3rd year is dependent on the students achieving satisfactory results and their continuing attendance at college.
- All eligible applications will be available for promotional purposes with PSCU.
- The winning students will be presented with a cheque to the value of €2,000 at the beginning of the academic year once proof of academic results / registration is available.
- The third level institution may be any of the Institutions as set out by the CAO. It may also be based
  outside of Ireland.
- The decision of the board of directors of the Public Service Credit Union is final. The board also reserves the right to make any adjustments of amendments to these rules as is necessary, at any time.
- Closing date for application is Friday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2020.
