When do you like to sleep?



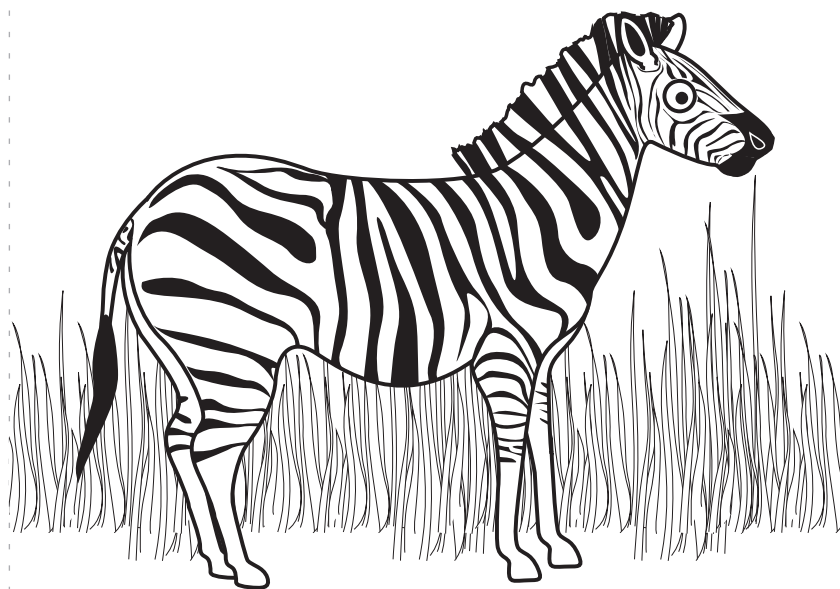

How do you like to stay cool?

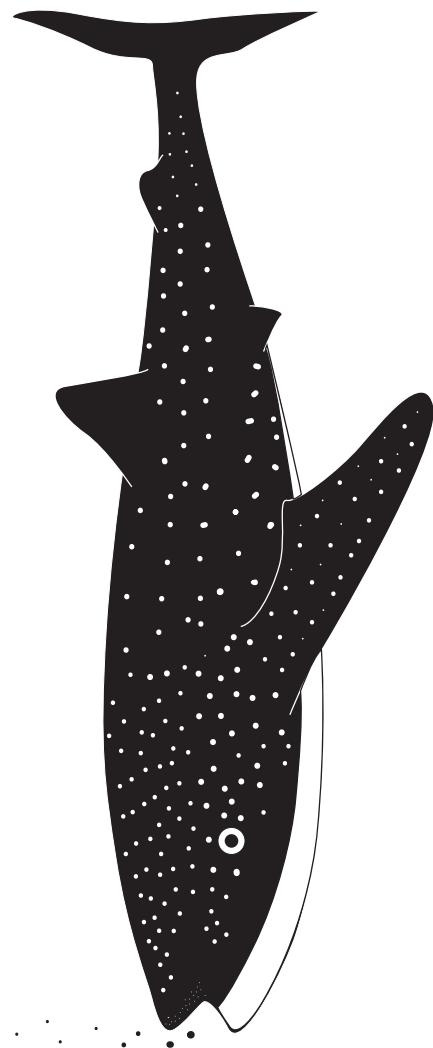
