WORKING HOURS:

Banks: 10am to 4pm, from Monday to Friday.

Government offices: from 9am to 5pm, from Monday to Friday.

Shopping Malls: from 10am to 10pm, from Monday to Saturday; on Sundays, from 2pm to 8pm.

HINTS

Water: Tap water is best avoided. Drink mineral water.

Drinks: The standard aperitif is a *Caipirinha*, made of fresh lime juice, sugar, cane spirit and ice. Local beer is mostly of *lager-type*, and of good quality. Try *Chopp* (local draft beer) and *Guaraná* (local soft drink, made from an Amazon fruit). In restaurants, some coffee shops, snack bars and bars you should try natural and fresh tropical fruit juices. There are some juices mixed with milk that are called in portuguese *Vitaminas*, that are made of an infinity of mixtures with fruit like mangoes, acerolas, pineapples, bananas, oranges and guavas and there is also the alcoholic drink called *Batida*, a typically Brazilian drink, mixed with ice cubes, fruit and sugar.

Food: The country has a rich regionalized cuisine. Each region has its festive food, but the *Feijoada*, originally from Rio de Janeiro, is considered by many the most typical Brazilian dish. It consists of a big casserole of black beans with a thick juice cooked together with salty fresh and smoked meat. In São Paulo and any other major capital in Brazil, you can get the cuisine of almost everywhere in the world, good quality food and reasonable prices, because of the diversity of the immigration: Italian, Chinese, Japanese, French etc. Other dishes worth trying in Brazil are Muqueca (stewed fish) and Rodízio / Churrasco (barbecued meat and poultry). São Paulo is very famous for the quality and variety of its pizza and restaurants.

TRANSPORTATION

Taxis: You can pick up a taxi on the street, a taxi cab or book by phone. We advise the use of apps (99Taxi, for example). We also have UBER in São Paulo.

Be aware that because of heavy traffic, journeys can take much longer than you might expect especially during the rush hours (7:30-10am and 5-8pm).

Subway: Working Hours: from 4:40am to 12am (Sunday to Friday) and from 4:40am to 1am (Saturday). Ticket must be acquired inside the subway stations. A one-way ticket (flat fare) costs R\$ 4,40.

Bus: Regular buses works from 5am to 12am (daily). There are also night lines working from 12am to 5am (daily). For further information about lines and itinerary, visit SPTrans website: <http://www.sptrans.com.br/> A one-way ticket costs R\$ 4,40.
