

Take and Make:

Mini Macramé Hanging Planter



- 1. Fold your four cords in half and poke the looped end through the ring, tying a knot.
- 2. Separate your strands into pairs. Tie a simple overhand knot in each pair at the point where you want your pot to sit.
- 3. Lay your project flat and separate your strands. Match one strand from each pair with a strand from an adjacent pair. Tie an overhand knot 1"-2" down from the first knot.
- 4. Split the pairs again, and tie more knots 1"-2" down.
- 5. Gather all the strands together 1"-3" below the last knots. Take one macramé cord and use it tie all the strands together. Trim the ends to your liking.
- 6. Add your pot, hang, and admire!
