

Take and Make:

Mini Macramé Hanging Planter



1. Fold your four cords in half and poke the looped end through the ring, tying a knot.
2. Separate your strands into pairs. Tie a simple overhand knot in each pair at the point where you want your pot to sit.
3. Lay your project flat and separate your strands. Match one strand from each pair with a strand from an adjacent pair. Tie an overhand knot 1"-2" down from the first knot.
4. Split the pairs again, and tie more knots 1"-2" down.
5. Gather all the strands together 1"-3" below the last knots. Take one macramé cord and use it to tie all the strands together. Trim the ends to your liking.
6. Add your pot, hang, and admire!
