A Word from the Reopening Task Force

A big thanks from the Reopening Task Force to all who responded to the survey of the congregation. The task force is closely monitoring the number of COVID cases in Pierce County, the vaccination rate, and other factors as we work towards resuming in-person worship. When we resume inperson worship, we will continue to offer online worship for those not able to worship in person.

As we consider which space to use for worship, we are looking closely at the air circulation in the sanctuary and the multipurpose room. By opening windows and using fans we can have excellent airflow in either space. We're also considering the tradeoff between the larger space in the MPR versus the technical challenges of broadcasting online worship from that space.

The survey results show a high vaccination rate within the congregation, which helps the task force be confident that with appropriate precautions (masks, space, airflow, and reduced capacity) we can safely resume in-person worship relatively soon; however since the COVID rate in Pierce County is currently rising we are not yet able to set a date.

Based on the widespread desire for in-person worship expressed by survey respondents, we anticipate needing some sort of system to manage capacity - ticketing, reservations, or something similar. We will need help from congregation members to serve as ushers, to help with technology, and in other roles to ensure our health precautions are effective.

Thanks again for your feedback via the survey. We look forward to the day that we can resume in-person worship, but continue on as the body of Christ even as we are separate from one another.
