memorize	verb	to learn something so that you will remember it exactly One way to learn a new vocabulary is to memorize it.
drill	verb	to repeat an exercise several times to practice a skill You may need to <b>drill</b> yourself to learn a specific grammar point.
overachiever	noun	a person who does more than they are expected to do Kiky is an <b>overachiever</b> for learning 5 languages in 6 months.
