gift	noun	something you give to someone; a present We have to get Gio a gift for his awesomeness.
present	noun	a gift, especially to show friendship, or to say thank you Kiky gave me free movie tickets as a present .
thought	noun	the act of thinking about something They don't give any thought to their appearance.
handmade	adjective	made using the hands rather than a machine I prefer giving handmade presents to my closer friends.
materialistic	adjective	believing that having possessions is the most important thing We're living in a highly materialistic society.
once in a while	idiom	sometimes but not often Kiky buys herself a present once in a while.
careful	adjective	done with or showing thought and attention It's best we be careful what we give as a present to our boss.
expect	verb	to think or to believe something will happen I expect you to get me a gift on my birthday, Gio.
constraint	noun	a limitation or restriction Time constraints can be a problem when buying gifts.
backtrack	verb	to go back to an earlier point We went the wrong way and had to backtrack a little bit.
