Roy P. Disney's offshore experience is extensive: Educated at St. Mary's College, he quickly started sailing with his family aboard many small sailboats and frequently crossed over to Catalina Island for family vacations at a very young age. His first offshore race, a competition to Ensenada, took place in 1968.

The 1975 Transpac marked Roy's inaugural appearance onboard his family's S&S yawl *Shamrock*; he returned to this world-renowned race again in '77, '79 and '81, followed by the "sled" years (the West Coast sled is defined as a 70ish footer that excels downwind, provides a very comfortable and fast ride for its size).

oy's first Transpac on a sled was in 1983 aboard a Santa Cruz 50 named *Samurai*; he competed aboard the first *Pyewacket*, a custom Nelson Merrick 68 in 1987, followed by additional Transpacs in '89, '91, '93, '95, '97 (elapsed time record holder), '99 (elapsed time record holder), 2001, '03, '05,

'07, '09, '11, '13, '15, '17, '19, '21 and '23. He currently holds the Transpac participation record (26 races) with Gary Weisman, who now sails onboard *Pyewacket* with Roy. In even number of years, he often participated in Pacific Cups and Vic Maui Races.

Roy currently holds the Newport Beach to Cabo San Lucas elapsed time record on his current boat, *Pyewacket 70*, a super charged Volvo 70.

When not competing locally, Roy sailed across the Atlantic in the 1992 Route of Discovery Race, the 1984 Olympic Trials in Solings and over 50 races in Mexico, a list that includes competitions in Cabo San Lucas, Puerto Vallarta, Manzanillo, Mazatlán and Ensenada. Between these races, he was a key crew member aboard yacht *PACT 95*, which narrowly missed qualifying for the America's Cup.

Roy, the current President of Shamrock Holdings, also serves on numerous boards of directors and plays a crucial role on the U.S. Naval Academy Fales Committee.

Cal Maritime, Harbor Cup champions in two off the last three regattas, will seek its ninth crown in the 16-race history of this event against the top collegiate offshore programs in the country.

After winning the John F. Kennedy Memorial trophy for the fifth time in school history in November of 2023, and becoming just the sixth school in that event's history to win back-to-back championships, the Keelhaulers seek another major trophy to their collection following its title-winning performance at the Shields Cup last October.






