Voting By Mail

Ballots will be mailed beginning Monday, October 1, 2018. If your application is received after October 1st, allow 3 to 5 business days for your application to be processed and your ballot to be mailed.

Voting In Person at the Election Commission

In person voting begins Tuesday, October 9, 2018 through Monday, November 5, 2018 during regular business hours and Saturday, November 3, 2018, 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

Pick up a Ballot for Someone Else

Limit of two (2) ballots per election that an agent may pick up for someone other than themselves.

Ballots may be picked up beginning Monday, October 1, 2018 through Tuesday, November 6, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Ballot Return

Ballots <u>must</u> be returned to the Election Commission or any postage free drop box location by **8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 6, 2018**. Drop boxes will be open from Monday, October 1, 2018 through Tuesday, November 6, 2018 at 8:00 p.m.

A list of drop box locations can be found at www.votedouglascounty.com, and the list will be included on the yellow instruction sheet enclosed with your ballot.
