STEEL FC LOOKS FOR SWEEP AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

Riding an seven-match unbeaten streak at Goodman Stadium, Bethlehem Steel FC looks get back to its winning ways when it hosts North Carolina FC on Saturday. Steel FC has yet to drop three consecutive matches and seeks its second series win of the year.

PREVIOUS MEETING

The two sides met for the first time on June 2, with Steel FC battling back from a first-half deficit with goals from Ben Ofeimu and Michee Ngalina in the 83rd and 85th minutes to begin a five-match unbeaten streak. The goal was Ofeimu's first professional goal and make the 16-year-old the youngest goalscorer in franchise history.

COACH'S CORNER

Bethlehem Steel FC head coach Brendan Burke:

On the loss to Atlanta United 2

"We beat ourselves, they were okay and energetic. They have some good individual players but ultimately we beat ourselves. We had a ton of chances and pressure on them in the second half. We miss an assignment on a set piece and give away a goal. Our first half after we hit the post, we didn't take a chance to get up early on the road then you are leaving them in a position where they can get into the game and they did so another highly disappointing first half for us. I think the person that influences in the game the most, I can't comment on for fear of a fine but ultimately that was a massive play that went unjudged and it left us in a position where we lost our brightest player in the game that had already hit the post and was unlocking their defense consistently and it was a vicious tackle so it was a tough night for us in a lot of ways. I'm glad we pushed and continued to try and find a winner but ultimately just was not good enough and I hope we feel the full weight of that because we can't continue to allow teams to stay in games when we get on top of them."

Another tough turnaround for Steel FC, what is the most important thing in trying to recover for Saturday

"Just physical recovery, we know [the Union] have the Frankfort game so we will be left really light for the game [against North Carolina FC] so we need everyone to at as close to full strength as possible. Recovery over the next two days becomes vital for us."

Trailing in the late stages on the road, Bethlehem Steel FC dug deep for a furious comeback with a pair of goals to defeat North Carolina FC, 2-1. Despite surrendering a set piece goal in the 16th minute, Steel FC answered in the 83rd and 85th minutes respectively on strikes from two of its youngest players in Ben Ofeimu and Michee Ngalina.

In search of an equalizer, Steel FC earned a crucial corner kick after Chris Nanco tried to connect with Ngalina. While the hosts defended the set piece, Santi Moar collected the headed clearance shielding off a defender before sending a high volley to the far post. Unmarked and in his club debut, Ofeimu calmed settled the pass and fired it into the back of the net for the equalizer. The strike was historic off the right foot of the 18-year-old as he became the first current member of the Philadelphia Union Academy to score for Bethlehem Steel FC.

Steel FC wouldn't be satisfied with just a draw as two minutes later it was Moar once again creating a goal. Coming off a goal kick from Jake McGuire, Steel FC captain James Chambers switched the point of attack with a blast to Moar on the far side of the field. The Spaniard collected it with two touches with his right foot before threading a pass in front of goal that was finished off by Ngalina.

Head coach Brendan Burke

Burke is in his third season as head coach of Bethlehem Steel FC, coaching the squad to an 24-33-23 regular season record during the club's first two seasons in the modern era. He was formally introduced as the club's first head coach on Oct. 29, 2015 and recently signed an extension to remain with Steel FC for the foreseeable future.

During his three seasons with Bethlehem Steel FC, he has navigated 78 different starting XI combinations in 80 career matches while guiding four players to first team contracts with Derrick Jones in 2016, the duo of Cory Burke and Matt Real after the 2017 season and Olivier Mbaizo earlier this year. Overall, Burke had coached 71 players including 29 players with ties to the first team and 17 from the Philadelphia Union Academy the past three seasons.

Prior to joining Steel FC, Burke served as an assistant coach for the Philadelphia Union from 2011 through 2014. He was heavily involved in all levels of the U.S. Soccer pyramid, including serving as head coach of the Union's PDL affiliate Reading United from 2008-13 where he had a record of 71-18-19. During his time with Reading, Burke coached 49 players that signed professional contracts including Ray Gaddis, C.J. Sapong, John McCarthy and Matt Hedges. Burke served as associate head coach at Northeastern University in 2015.



Assistant coach Stephen Hogan

Hogan, who formerly served as the head coach of the Philadelphia Union's PDL affiliate, Reading United, is in his third season with Steel FC.

Hogan guided the PDL squad to a 22-5-1 record in his two seasons with Reading United. The club went 10-3-1 and won the Mid-Atlantic Division title along with an appearance in the Eastern Conference finals. Hogan followed up with an even stronger 12-2-0 record in 2017, tying for the most wins in the 72-team league. During the season that saw the club reach the postseason for the ninth time in 10 seasons, Hogan's squad conceded an Eastern Conference-low 10 goals. As a Reading player under Brendan Burke, he made 52 appearances, second most in club history, while playing from 2007-10. He helped lead the team to the 2009 PDL Regular Season Title and the PDL National Semifinals in 2008 and 2010. A native of Dublin, Ireland, Hogan spent two seasons as head coach at the College of Saint Rose's men's soccer program.
