

THE SELECTION PROCESS

- Send your CV and a cover letter related to the project to candidates@vicolocorto.org
- 2. Then you will be contacted for a Skype interview. There is no need of speaking good English, in case you can ask your sending organization to help you. Don't worry, it will not be a job interview or an English test but it will be an opportunity to know your personal motivation and expectation and to discuss about the project, the city and the opportunities.

THE PROFILE OF THE VOLUNTEERS

The volunteer's profile our organization is looking for is based on the following criteria:

- **Personal motivations.** We value the volunteers' interest in the programme proposed and the expectation towards this experience more than specific skills: everything you need to do your service will be learnt here!
- **English and Italian level.** Italian or English are not needed, of course, a survival level will be helpful to get by in everyday needs, especially because you will be probably in touch with people who don't generally speak foreign languages. This experience is also your opportunity to improve your communication skills!
- Interest in working with people. Working with people is essential to our work. We also value creative, proactive and self-motivated people.



MORE ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS

VICOLOCORTO is the Coordinating Organisation taking care of the practical, follow-up, support and training arrangements during your volunteering project.

ACCOMODATION

You have the opportunity to enjoy the volunteering life in a flat with other volunteers. Cleanliness is everyone's job. Volunteers are expected to reach an agreement on planning house cleaning. If you have problems finding an agreement, we help you and support you in finding a solution.

Sharing, we know, is not easy, it is even harder when you do not know the other people you are living with, who have decided as you, to start this experience. But **flexibility**, **understanding** and most of all **communication** are the keys for having a positive experience, even if everything won't be perfect!

The lodging of anyone outside our project (friends, family, etc ...) is not allowed.

ATTITUDE

You will spend most of the time with different people (target groups, professionals, local volunteers, etc...) who are anxious to know you, to show you who they are and what they can do, to teach you at different levels, to give you warmth and their confidence. The impact that you can bring as a volunteer is greater than you can expect. You need to receive but also to give back. PESARO



Pesaro is a city and Municipality in the Italian region of Marche, capital of the Province of Pesaro e Urbino, on the Adriatic Sea, with a population of around 95.011 inhabitants, making it the second most populous city in the region, after Ancona.

Pesaro is recognised as "Cycling City" (Città della Bicicletta) in recognition of its **extensive network of bicycle paths** and promotion of cycling. It is also known as "**City of Music**" as it is the birthplace of the composer **Gioacchino Rossini**. The historical centre of Pesaro is rich of points of interest like Palla di Pomodoro, the Conservatorio, the theatre, the museums, the fountain in the main square and casa Rossini.

It is located between **two coastal hills**, the San Bartolo and the Ardizio, so you can **enjoy both the seaside** and **hiking in the hills**. The San Bartolo, in particular, is a Natural Park so you can also discover its beauty and the small towns near it.

Thanks to Rossini, **Pesaro is famous for Pizza Rossini**: a pizza garnished with tomato sauce , mozzarella, boiled eggs and mayonase. It can sound weird at the beginning, but you have to try!

The association

The association Vicolocorto is a cultural youth **association that specializes in youth work and international mobility**. It is based in Pesaro and works at a regional level (Regione Marche) cooperating with private and public institutions. The main activities of the association are connected with European projects since Vicolocorto works as coordinating organisation for different volunteering projects in the region and is part of several national and international networks.

The main activities of the association are connected with international mobility. The association mainly organises intercultural and educational activities and English conversation workshops and non formal activities aimed at improving the practice of foreign languages. Moreover, an important part of the activities is connected with the promotion of the opportunities of international mobility in schools, Youth Info Points and Job Centres. Finally, Vicolocorto is partner of different strategic partnerships with other European countries and writes publications on formal education and on youth work quality at a European level.



The Committee

The Italian Association of the Red Cross aims to provide health and social care both in times of peace and in times of conflict. The guarantee and guide of the actions of every volunteer and employee of the Red Cross are the **seven Fundamental Principles** of the International Movement of the Red Cross, which constitute its spirit and ethics: *Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Volunteerism, Unity* and *Universality*.

The Committee of Pesaro is today a reality that can count on over 300 volunteers engaged in different activities, divided into six macro areas: health, social, emergencies, principles and values, young people and development.

Every year, the local Committee of Pesaro organises the "**Run for Red Cross**" **marathon**, which is an important event to raise funds that attracts around 400 runners for 10 km.

Tasks of the volunteers

The volunteers will be involved to the activities organised by the local Red Cross in 5 different areas. The volunteers WILL NOT be involved in emergency situations and WILL NOT deal with First Aid interventions.

They will be involved in the following activities:

- Social and cultural entertainment activities in rest homes for eldery people;
- Food distribution activities: the volunteers will take part to distribution of food to poor families;
- Homeless support activities: they support the homeless with the distribution of blankets and warm food in winter and with the distribution of food and water in summer;
- **Information and awareness campaigns**: meetings with students and organising prevention and intervention workshops about different topics and issues (first aid, drug and alcohol abuse, prevention of diseases...);
- Fundraising office: support in the fundraising campaigns, as the annual charity event.

YOUTH CENTRE TOTEM




The Centre

The Youth Centre TOTEM is located in a suburban area of Pesaro and it involves youngsters and children with disabilities aiming at reinforcing the sense of inclusion and community.

The Centre is open every afternoon from 3 to 8 o'clock. Since the Centre has a kitchen, every Wednesday they have dinner together and the staff is there also in the evening. The target groups are both children and youngsters until 30: Monday and Wednesday are the days where there are more activities dedicated to youngsters, whereas the other days are dedicated to children. There is a great sense of cooperation that breaks down the age barrier anyway.

The main objectives of the youth center are to promote active citizenship through activities and debates and to promote inclusive and integration process among youngsters through socialization activities without barriers.





Tasks of the volunteers

The TOTEM Youth Centre organizes daily activities for children and young people. The activities also involve children and young people with disabilities and aims to strengthen the sense of community in the suburban area of Pesaro by providing social services aimed to reinforce the action towards inclusion.

The volunteers will be involved in the daily activities of the Youth Centre, such as:

- **Homework support** for youngsters and kids;
- Games and sport inside and outside the Centre;
- Creative and artistic workshops;
- Linguistic and intercultural activities;
- **Events** in cooperation with other Youth Centres of Pesaro.

AIAS, Provincial Section of Pesaro and Urbino, is an NGO that works to protect the rights of disabled people by promoting initiatives and activities aimed at satisfying the needs of all adults with serious psycho-physical disabilities and at improving their quality of life.

AIAS deals, in fact, with people with severe mental and physical disabilities trying to guarantee them a better life and a real social integration. Therefore, the association is there to support people with disabilities, but also to **inform the community regarding the problems of persons with disabilities and their families**, in order to contribute to their full social integration in the community.

The section of Pesaro manages a **Daily Centre** and a **Residential Centre**. The "Anna Giardini" Rehabilitation Day Centre is open from Monday to Friday providing its services to about 14 people with severe and medium serious disabilities.

It remains open from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, guaranteeing its guests a complete meal, that they have all together.









Tasks of the volunteers

The section of Pesaro manages a Daily Centre where the volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- Music Workshops that facilitate and foster communication, relationship, learning, motor skills, expression, organization and other relevant therapeutic goals in order to meet physical, emotional, mental, social and cognitive needs.
- Cooking workshop: since they all have lunch together everyday, they organise cooking workshop to learn to cook first and then to share the meals.
- **Trips around the city**: the association tries to make the users of the centre move around our city. Since they are not able to do it on their own, the social workers support them in moving, like going to the market, having a walk on the beach or having a meal all together outside the centre.



The Centre

The "T41A" Daytime Social Rehabilitation and Educational Centre is a place that aims at social integration for people with disability through the development of the maximum personal autonomy possible, the learning of technical and operational skills and the improvement of communication skills.

It promotes the use of the resources available in the territory, so as to promote the exchange between the Centre, its users and the local community, avoiding the marginalization of people.

The Day Centre allows a daily life according to the rhythms that safeguard and enhance individual and group meetings between users and operators. The service has the additional objective of activating different organizational models defined as mixed "School - Day Centre" paths, which benefit not only its users but also young students with disabilities, unable to live a real integration within the social context, such as the school for example, offering an acquisition of experiences in a protected and safe context represented by the Day Centre. They cooperate with other local realities, and they managed to organise a musical in the theatre and a movie in the cinema with their users as actors and now they are starting to film the second movie.







Tasks of the volunteers

The volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- Theatre/acting workshop: every year the Centre has a project in cooperation with other local realities about acting.
- Music Workshop: this is a group activity based on rhythm and self-expression through music.
- Cooking workshops: on a weekly basis, the staff organise cooking workshops so that the users can be involved in the cooking activities and learn new skills.
- Dance workshop: this is a group workshop, through which the users are free to move around and dance in order to discharge their energy and emotions.
- Outdoor activities: from time to time, the staff organise outdoor activities for the users of the Centre that can help them to discover the city where they live and to build a relationship with nature.

CAMPOBASE



The cooperative

CAMPO BASE is a social cooperative and it was established as a type B social cooperative, which means its main aim is the inclusion of disadvantaged people and people with fewer opportunities through work integration activities. It operates in the sector of fruit and vegetable and livestock sector according to the organic method.

They organise **social integration activities** thanks to projects with schools and other urban realities. This last innovative aspect of the company allows to bring any citizen closer to new realities, such as **disability** and **respect of the environment** in which we live.

Today Campo Base, together with its working partners, **cultivates about ten hectares of land** (vegetables) and raises a small courtyard animals, following a **natural, ecological method** and above all respecting the individual.

They support **the principle of "ZERO WASTE"**, since all waste is reused not only for feeding the chickens but also for composting. In this sector too, both agricultural workers and workers from disadvantaged categories are involved. They sell their agricultural products in the market in a shop and in a restaurant that they manage.

Tasks of the volunteers

The volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- Activities of transplanting and sorting: the volunteers will support the staff and the users of the cooperative in transplanting plants in the vegetable garden and in keeping the plants free from animals and from other infesting plants. Once the plants have grown, they will support in the picking and sorting of the vegetables.
- Gardening and cleaning: the volunteers will support the staff in keeping clean the green areas where they work. They will take care of the flowerbeds and of the common areas.
- Care of the poultry: the cooperative grows poultry in the farm and the volunteers will support the staff in the animal care by helping them with the feeding and management of the henhouse.
- Activities with children: they organise educational activities for schools and children in order to raise awareness about ecology and respect of our planet. The volunteers will support in the organisation of these events and activities and they will support the staff in the implementation phase.

Each volunteer can take part in the courses organised by the local Committee, such as the First Aid course, in order to acquire professional training.

SENIGALLIA



Senigallia is a municipality and port town on the Adriatic coast in the Marche region. It is situated in the province of Ancona and it counts around 44.460 inhabitants. Senigallia is an important touristic destination, especially in summer with **his velvet beaches** and **spectacular festivals**. In particular, each August the "Summer Jamboree" Festival animates the city with music, art, shows and markets coming directly from the Fifties. There's also a nationally recognised music event during which different Italian singers take part for free concerts.

The Rotonda a Mare is the typical postcard of Senigallia: it was built at the beginning of the 20th century and it is now one of the main places for conventions and art exhibitions. The beaches are always crowded in summer and various cultural events animate the other seasons.

CENTRO INTERCUTURALE LE RONDINI



The Centre

The Intecultural Centre "le Rondini" is a daily multicultural centre for children and teenagers created by Le Rondini Onlus whose aim is to **provide spaces and moments for social inclusion, intercultural learning, active citizenship, fostering youth participation**.

Its main activity consists in supporting the after school daily tasks of children and youngsters between 6 and 16 years old. They organize recreational activities for Italian and foreign children, especially non-European migrants, and create a network of relations offering learning activities for their families (in particular Italian language courses and the sewing course for mothers and women).

The Intercultural Centre is **open on a daily basis** and has a permanent partnership with the town hall of Senigallia and with many local primary and secondary schools in order to promote volunteering and social inclusion through active participation, intercultural approach and active citizenship.







Tasks of the volunteers

The volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- Homework support for immigrant and Italian children;
- Activities with immigrant women, especially support to the sewing course and Italian language course;
- Promotional activities and linguistic workshops for youngsters in cooperation with the Youth Info Centre of Senigallia;
- **Events** in cooperation with other local organisations to promote cultural diversity and European opportunities for youngsters;
- **Summer camps** for children.

The Centre

The Olympic centre was established in 1955 and since then it has allowed to practice both social and competitive table tennis. It follows the principles of the European Chart of Sport (Rodi 1992) and for this reason **it turns to youth, adults and seniors with no discrimination** based on sex, race, religion or position.

Main goals of the organization are integration, socialization, education, physical activities, competitive sport activities, promotion of diversity, tolerance and respect, critical thinking, initiative spirit of youth and prevention of violent radicalization.

Our organization carry out different activities for 120 members from 8 to 78 years old, of which, 50% is under the age of 18, males and females, both with disabilities and without, both Italian and foreign. In addition, we work closely with local schools of Senigallia, with Social Service of the town hall, with different charities for special needs children and with the Italian table tennis federation. Part of the activities includes regional and national tournaments, training and teaching modules, recreational games and leisure activities.

ANCONA

Ancona is the main city of the Marche region, it is located on the Adriatic coast and it counts around 102.000 inhabitants. The city is located between the slopes of the two extremities of the promontory of Monte Conero, Monte Astagno and Monte Guasco: that is why it is not only a **beach destination** but also a hiking one. Ancona is the main seaport of the region, so it is **easy to travel** here by boat.

In being the main and biggest city of the region, there are **a lot of events** and also important **concerts** organised during the year.

One of the symbols of the city is the "Passetto", a rocky beach which is accessible by long stairs and which is a typical summer destination for locals.

The **Monte Conero** is a natural park and it has different hiking trails that can bring you to the most famous and beautiful beaches of the entire region.


The Centre

The cooperative Centro Papa Giovanni XXIII was founded with the aim of creating spaces for aggregation and animation for people with disability, thus responding to a real need of a part of the citizenship.

Centro Papa Giovanni XXIII manages **Day Centres** and **Residential Centres** for people with disability and **their users are from 25 to 63 years old**. The activities the Centres offers to them are diversified and have educational purposes: the workshops usually change every week and also according to the season and the period of the year.

In the cooperative there is a high level of democracy and the staff tries to be as inclusive as they can but they know that their work alone is not enough, that is why they have built a **network with other local realities** in order to foster inclusion for people with disability not only in their facilities but also outside.

In general, they have 28 disabled people between 26 and 64 years old coming to the Day Centre and 8 or 9 disabled people for each Residential Community.







Tasks of the volunteers

The volunteers will support the staff of the Day Centre and Residential Centre in the organisation.

The volunteers will be involved in the following activities:

- Theatre workshops
- Cooking workshops: they have a solidarity catering in which the users of the Centre are involved. They learn first how to cook thanks to the workshops and then they take part in the solidarity catering during party or events.
- Solidarity wedding favours: some users of the Centre prepare on their own wedding favours with special instruments that have been designed for them to use independently.
- Orienteering and autonomy/independence workshops: these workshops are intended to help the users to improve in terms of independence and autonomy. The staff teach them and help them in practice with public transport, shopping and orienteering in the town.
- Social media workshops

CINGOLI

Cingoli is a small town of around 10.100 inhabitants located at 630 meters above sea level, in the province of Macerata in the Marche region.

Cingoli is a **medieval town** and it is also **known as the "Balcony of Marche"** ("Il Balcone delle Marche") because of its *belvedere* (viewpoint) from which, on a clear day, the sight may encompass all of the Marche and further across the Adriatic Sea. In being a small town in the Marche hills, it offers **a lot of opportunities to enjoy nature**, **hiking** and **day trips**.

Very close to Cingoli, for example, there is a **lake** where there are bars and restaurants and where you can relax on the beaches.

In particular, the Croce Rossa Italiana – Comitato di Cingoli was born as a Group of the Volunteers of the Red Cross of Macerata in 1993 and then recognised as a separate Committee in 1998. It can count now on the support of around 403 volunteers among the three main cities in the area: Cingoli, Apiro and Monte San Vicino. As regards the youth area, the Committee can count on a group of 90 youngsters, who organise a lot of activities in the area, especially projects and campaigns regarding responsible drinking.

The volunteers are involved in the activities organized by the Local Committee of Cingoli, which is located within the area affected by the earthquake between 2016 and 2017. The volunteers WILL NOT be involved in emergency situations and WILL NOT deal with First Aid interventions.

The volunteers will contribute to the following services:

- Support the **Red Cross Youth Group**;
- Take part in informative and awareness campaigns;
- Organization of events related to responsible drinking;
- **Support to training courses** about First AID and road safety;
- Support to internal communication strategy of the Red Cross;
- **Informative activities** at school;
- Support the care of **elderly** and **people with disability**;
- Take part in informative activities about **health and proper nutrition**.
- Support to the Red Cross' staff during motocross events.
