Community Updates from the Town of Pike Road Regarding COVID-19

Pike Road, ALA – Please see a few updates from the Town of Pike Road regarding community activities and municipal facilities. These policies reflect the importance of social distancing and the statewide Safer at Home Order, issued on April 28. The Town of Pike Road's top priority continues to be safely serving the people of Pike Road, and we want to emphasize that we are in this together: Each of us has a personal responsibility to be smart and keep our community safe!

- Based on the Safer at Home Order and recommendations of social distancing, Town Hall and all municipal facilities will continue to be closed to public access through May 15, 2020. This policy applies to locations such as Founders Station, the Pike Road Arts Center, Natural Trail Trailhead Facilities, and the Recycling Depot. This also includes the Community Ball Field and playground at Veterans Park and the Rolling Hills playground.
- The Town of Pike Road has extended the suspension of events at municipal facilities through May 15. Events following May 15 are being evaluated, and any changes or updates to this policy will be based primarily on CDC and ADPH recommendations.
- The curfew, announced on April 2, continues be in effect every night from 10 p.m. 5 a.m. until further notice. Based on social distancing recommendations and local policies, the curfew limits public outings between the hours of 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
