Activity: “Not an Artist” Art

Category: Culture – Arts and Crafts

Suggested Grade Level: Grades 7-12

Description:

Create your own art and show off your creativity by adding it to your room décor.

Supplies:

- White construction paper
- Black construction paper
- Black marker (like a Sharpie)
- Your favorite colored markers
- Scissors
- Glue



Instructions:

1. Start by closing your eyes. While keeping your eyes closed, use your black sharpie to freely draw on the white sheet of paper.
2. Open your eyes. Grab your favorite brightly colored markers and start filling in the white spaces. Avoid the dark-colored markers.
3. Try to spread out your colors evenly. Add in a color you have not used.

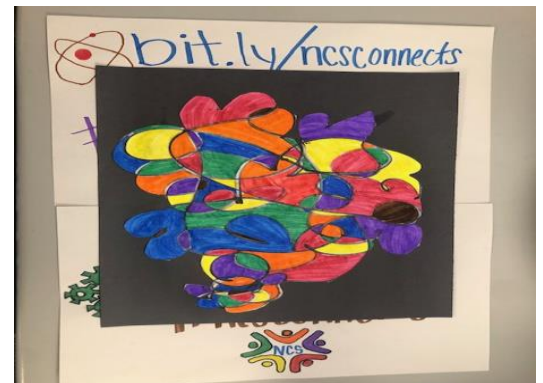
4. Cut out the piece by following the most outer perimeter lines of your drawing.



5. Place your cut-out art on the black construction paper and attach it using glue. Pat the front and back of the piece so that the glue spreads out evenly.



6. Hang your art piece wherever you would like and enjoy!
