New Street site

Year 1 – to be dropped off at 8.40 a.m. and picked up at 3.00 p.m from Gate 4 (Minibus gate) TIME CHANGE Year 2 – to be dropped off at 8.40 a.m. and picked up at 3.00 p.m from Gate 3 (Crossing patrol gate) TIME CHANGE Year 3 - to be dropped off from 8.50 a.m. and picked up at 3.10 p.m from Gate 3 (Crossing patrol gate)

Year 4 – to be dropped off from 8.50 a.m. and picked up at 3.10 p.m from Gate 2 (main school gate)
Year 5 – to be dropped off from 8.50 a.m. and picked up at 3.10 p.m from Gate 2 (main school gate)
Year 6 - to be dropped off from 8.50 a.m. and picked up at 3.10 p.m from Gate 1 (gate near Peniel Church)

Please remember that older siblings can arrive the same time as their youngest sibling, and be collected at home time the same time.
