Different People Different Goal

What is Development?

Development is a comprehensive term which include increase in real per capita income. Improvement in standard of living of people, reduction in poverty, illiteracy, etc



What development would mean for Different People?

Category of a Person	Developmental Goals
1. Landless rural labourers	More days of work and better wages.
2. Prosperous farmers from Punjab	Assured a high family income through higher support prices for their crops.
3. Farmers who depend only on rain for growing crops	Better irrigation facilities.
4. Urban unemployed youth	Secured employment.
5. A girl from a rich urban family	She gets as much freedom as her brother and is able to decide what she wants to do in life.

What did we learn?

1. Different persons can have **different developmental goals**.
2. People can even have conflicting goal.

NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT

What is National development?

It refers to the ability of a nation to improve the lives of its citizens. It can be in the field of agriculture, Industries, education, health, etc.



HOW TO COMPARE DIFFERENT COUNTRIES OR STATES?

Countries are classified on the basis of income

What is a country's Income?

Country's income is calculated by the total income of all the people who are earning.



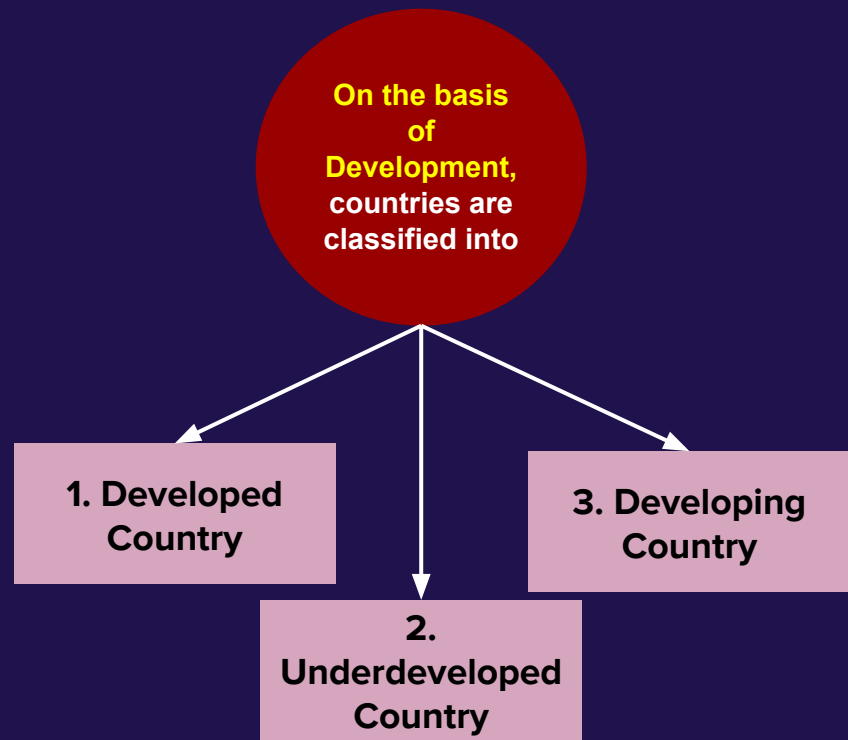
World Bank gives the classification of countries on the basis of:

Average Income or Per Capita Income: It will be calculated based on money earned per person in the specific area of a certain year.

Per Capita Income: $\frac{\text{Total Income of the Country}}{\text{Total Population}}$

Total Population





India comes in the category of low middle income countries (or Developing countries).



Countries with per capita income of US\$ 12,056 per annum and above in 2017, are called **rich countries**.

Countries with per capita income of **US\$ 955** or less are called **low-income countries**.

India belong to the category of low middle income countries because its per capita income in **2017 was just US\$ 1820** per annum.

World Bank Development Report

Pros:

- It gives clear understanding of income of the countries.
- It set specific parameters of comparison such as national income and per Capita income.

Cons:

- It considers only income and not other aspects such as literacy, health, life expectancy, etc.
- Only tells about income and not how it is distributed among the citizens.
