- To enable NGOs to consolidate and disseminate the **practice experience** and positive impact through different channels


Content of NIH

- Delivered by HKCSS, with the strategic partner Department of Social Work, Hong Kong Baptist University
- Cover **two batches** of community partnership programmes (2021-2022 and 2022-2023)



Training Programmes for NGOs

- 10 Community Partnership Programme (CPP) grantees invited to join the NIH
- 3 advanced workshops for invited grantees to boost the knowledge of programme planning and implementation of community development practice before the project launch (from July 2021)



Professional Consultancy Service for NGOs

- Each invited CPP grantees will be assigned a service consultant to strengthen the project implementation
- **3 consultation sessions** for each grantees will be arranged throughout the project implementation



Knowledge Sharing

- E-newsletters issued to consolidate practice insights from NGOs (10 case analyses)
- **Conference** organized to share practice wisdom on community development (tentative schedule: December 2022)
- Engaging international dialogue of community development practices, with the local practice insights
