
Puzzling Plumage

• Male has distinctive purpley-blue patch • Water loving Tall, heron-like Smooth white feathers repel water Named for its violet-toned feathers • Strong nut-cracking beak Male has a dark mask Named for its red-coloured wing tips • Male is mostly black Often found sitting on cattails Large white beak Male has a red chest


