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Teamsters Local 20 Charity Fund will sponsor at least one Norm Lewallen Memorial Scholarship, in the amount of \$1000 each year for one graduating senior with at least one parent working in a Teamster industry who is a member in good standing with Teamsters Local 20. Also, any member in good standing with Local 20 wishing to continue their education is eligible.

- I. The scholarship will be awarded on the following basis:
  - A. Procedure for making application for scholarship:
    1. The application form of the Scholarship Committee of Teamsters Local 20 must be completed by each applicant.
  - B. Qualifications of candidates who wish to make application for scholarship:
    1. Candidates must rank in the upper half of high school class or be a member in good standing at Teamsters Local 20.
    2. Candidates must present evidence that they have made choice of course of academic or technical training which would require at least one school year for completion.
    3. The Committee will personally review each Candidate's application.
    4. The Candidate must show he/she has been accepted by the school of choice before the scholarship is awarded.
  - C. Deadline for filing application with the Scholarship Committee will be May 31st.
  - D. An alternate will be chosen in case of default by the first winner.
  - E. The scholarship winner must return scholarship (money) to Teamsters Local 20 if he/she fails to attend college that year and/or receives a "full-ride" scholarship.
  - F. The scholarship(s) awarded are non-renewable.
