



Consent Form to Online KKU-AELT Test Terms

Center for English Language Excellence, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Khon Kaen University

Given that the COVID-19 pandemic crisis tends to become more severe, the government has declared a national state of emergency to prohibit public gatherings, stipulating that any act in violation of this emergency decree will result in penalties. Considering the safety of students and people wishing to use KKU-AELT test results to apply for admission to graduate studies and for graduation, the Center of English Language Excellence, hence, is to administer a KKU-AELT online test, pursuant to the government's declaration of the emergency decree.

Considering that the KKU-AELT online test is administered under unusual circumstances, students and people wishing to take the test shall agree to the online test terms as follows:

1. Test-takers shall be cooperative and comply with the proctor's instruction.
2. The commitment of acts of cheating in any form during the test is not allowed and condoned.
3. Prior to taking the test, test-takers must present to the proctor a national ID card or a government-issued ID card (in case of foreign test-takers, the first page of a passport must be presented).
4. Any test-taker who does not prepare the equipment for the online test will not be permitted to take the test.
5. Any test-taker who enters the online test room after the test has started will not be permitted to enter the online test room, except any justification depending on the director of the Center of English Language Excellence's discretion.
6. The writing test will be submitted to Turnitin to detect plagiarism. If the plagiarism percentage exceeds 20 percent, the writing test will not be marked.
7. Test results are considered final.

Any test-taker who does not agree to the terms of the online KKU-AELT test is allowed to contact the Center of English Language Excellence to make a request for test postponement to the next round prior to the test date.
