Covid-19 - Keeping us all safe

As we know, Covid-19 is still within the community, and we must all play our part to keep Covid 19 out of school. Staff continue to engage in twice a week Lateral Flow Testing, and as a school, we will continue to stay in our class bubbles until the end of this month and continue to encourage effective hand hygiene routines throughout the day.

Thank you to our families that have been proactive this week in keeping us informed of illness, testing and confirmed cases – we must all support each other to ensure we have a less disruptive year.

If your child presents with one of the three main symptoms:

A new or continuous cough A high temperature

A loss of or change to sense of smell or taste

They **must not** be sent to school and should be tested using a PCR test at a testing centre.

Isolation rules have changed, and we hope as schools that this will mean that whole classes will not have to isolate if there is a positive case in a class. I will update you when we have more clarity.

For the time being, staff will continue to wear face coverings at drop off and pick up, and visitors will be asked to wear face coverings to enter the school site.
