## Junkrig for a Kelt 8.50

This junkrig was designed for **Ketil Greve**'s Kelt 8.50, in Stavanger. Ketil made the sail and got the rig operational in the spring of 2021.

The design of the sail is based on the Johanna-style master sail with AR=1.90. In fact, the lower four panels are direct 1:1 copy of the sail of my *Ingeborg*. The 3-panel top section has been modified to take a 60° yard, still with each panel of the same area as in the lower one, The reason for the lower yard angle was to fit the aft-set mast position. The sail is now setting with at least 22% mast balance, and with a near-vertical halyard.

The sail is rigged without a *Throat Hauling Parrel*, THP, only with *Yard Hauling Parrel*, YHP, and Hong Kong parrels (..plus batten parrels, of course...). I guess the upper batten parrel prevents the sail from shifting too far forward.

The sail looks good in action and appears to perform well, despite its moderate size.
