Twirling is easy when you use the Studio 180 Design Corner Beam and Split Rects tool. There are three fabrics in this block: a background, a light or medium fabric, and a dark fabric. You can combine different colors to create some interesting looks with this block by playing around with the colors.

Using the blocks cutting chart below, determine the size you wish to make. Refer to the Corner Beam®, Split Rects® tool instructions.









Cutting Instructions: Per Block


Units Name and # of Units	6"	12"	18"
A: Corner Beam 4 units	2" Finished 2 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 ½" cut sized	6" Finished 6 ½" cut sized
B: Split Rects Type 1 & 2 2 Type 1 Units 2 Type 2 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
B: Split Rects Type 1 2 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
C: Rectangles 4 Units	1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized





Block Assembly


- 1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
- Stitch the rows together, press seams open.Make (1) Block.
