A simple way to jazz up a Lemoyne Star block is to frame it with some basic units. Adding Flying Geese and Half Square Triangles to a Traditional Lemoyne Star Block adds dimension and fun. The Traditional Lemoyne Stars could even be swapped out for one of the Studio 180 Design Lemoyne Star Techniques.






C: Half Square Triangle

Cutting Instructions: Per Block


Units Name and # of Units	9"	12"	18"
A: Lemoyne Star	6" Finished	8" Finished	12" Finished
1 Units	6 ½" cut sized	8 1/2" cut sized	12 ½" cut sized
B: Flying Geese 4 Units	1½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
C: Half Square Triangles	1 ½" Finished	2" Finished	3" Finished
12 Units	2" cut sized	2 1/2" cut sized	3 1/2" cut sized





Block Assembly

- Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
 Make (1) Block.


