The optical illusion this block creates gives you the impression of many layers of rotating squares. In addition to the Shaded Four Patch Technique Sheet, this block features the V Block, Tucker Trimmer, and Corner Pop tools. Light, medium, and dark fabrics are recommended for this block.

Note: You can find the directions you need to make this block in the instructions for V Block®, Tucker Trimmer® I, and Corner Pop® tool instructions. You will also need the Shaded Four Patch Technique Sheet.

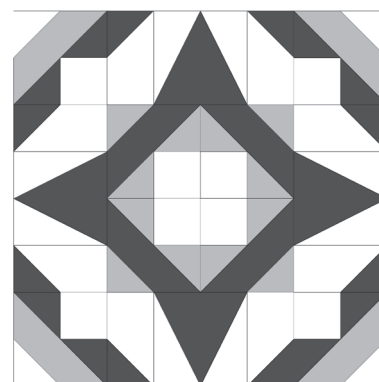
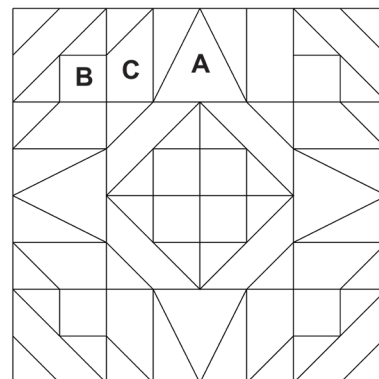

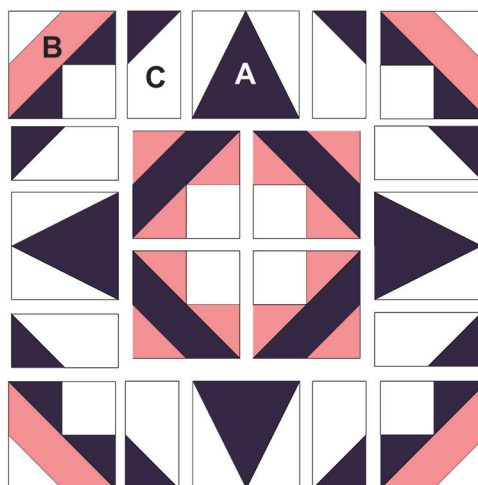

<b>A: V Block</b> 4 Units	1 1/2" Finished 2" cut sized	3" Finished 3 1/2" cut sized	4" Finished 4 1/2" cut sized
<b>B: Popped Rectangles</b> 8 Units	3/4" x 1 1/2" Finished 1" x 1 3/4" cut sized	1 1/2" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized
<b>Corner Pop® I</b> - Finished / Cut Away size on Corner Pop® I tool / Corner Trim Down Line			
	3/4" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	1 1/2" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	2" Finished Size / Cut Away Size
<b>C: Popped Shaded Four Patch</b> 8 Units	1 1/2" Finished 2" cut sized	3" Finished 3 1/2" cut sized	4" Finished 4 1/2" cut sized

1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as desired.
3. Stitch the rows together, pressing as desired.

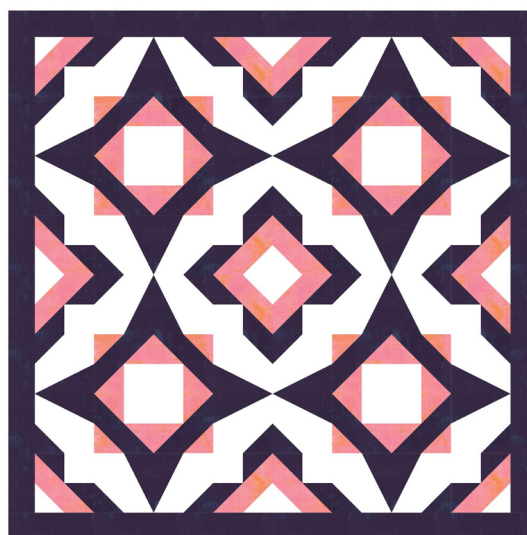
