




Market "pricing" 200 bps of Fed rate cuts over next 18 months





Alphabet trading at highest since August as Wall Street cheers Google's A.I. plans

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POINTS

- Shares of Alphabet are trading at their highest level since August on the heels of Google's artificial intelligence announcements at its developer conference Wednesday.
- At its I/O event, Alphabet-owned Google announced it would bring Al features to its signature search product to turn complex queries into simple answers by synthesizing results.
- Analysts seemed pleased that Google's announcements will keep it at the forefront
 of the AI race and generate returns for the company.
