

# Made It Society for May

Okay, this will be a bit different but I just want to play with a few techniques I have seen around the web! I am going to give you a list of supplies to have on hand but we are gonna cut and create together during class.

First, you will need your usual supplies, what we call your Make It Kit

Trimmer

Scissors (big and small)

Pokey Tool

Pencil

Scoreboard and Bone Folder

Ruler

Glue (wet, sticky tape and foam)

Cloth to clean up messes

Any tools you routinely work with as well.

SNACKS!

For this crafting session I want to play with acetate. I have three ideas, one that involves embossing, one the is creating “negative” space and one that will make easy and fun photo spots for a scrapbook layout.

You will want to gather:

- Acetate: 1 a sheet that can be an A2 card base and a second sheet for our photo spots and negative space card.
- Embossing folder, a large one if you have it, if not we can just run it through twice.
- Border punch of any kind.
- I will be using our new stamp sets, Type OH and Rejoicing in Hope.
- You’ll need blocks and ink, nothing special as we will not be stamping on the acetate.
- Dies, nesting if you have them, any shape as long as they are smaller than the front of an A2 card. If you don’t have dies, we can just make squares or rectangles.
- Card stock. I will be creating my own card bases, and I will use 12 x 12 for my scrapbook layout. If you have a 12 x 12 pack or even a few left over pages you can play along.

Don’t over thing the supplies, just be where you keep your supplies and we will have plenty of time to just play with what we have. Remember, the first ones of any projects we make are just samples or testers, you can make the real deal later.

For best participation, we suggest having two screens. One to watch and one to chat, for example, use your computer or TV to watch the projects and your phone or tablet to chat in the livestream. This is not necessary but it is helpful.

Made It Society is not a class so it does not function as our live classes do, this is more of a Make-a-long so we will just craft together and have fun! Class will open at 10am CST. Not early like our traditional online classes do.
