
Governors meet once per term (3 x per year) and are encouraged to visit during the school day at other times.

## Nursery admissions now from age 3 years old

Woodcroft Nursery now accepts applications for children to start from the age of 3 years old. We enrol children at the start of each term when they are three:

- For a September start date a child must turn 3 before 31st August.
- For a **January** start date a child must turn 3 between 1st September and 31st December.
- For an April start date a child must turn 3 before the last day in February (28th/29th)

Applications for Woodcroft Nursery are made directly to the school. You can register your child for our waiting list at any age. Please contact the Main Office to register or book a visit.

For the current 2023 – 2024 academic year the key admissions dates are:

September 2023 start – born between 1st September 2019 to 31st August 2020.

January 2024 start – born between 1st September 2020 to 31st December 2020

April 2024 start - born between 1st January 2021 and 31st March 2021

2024 - 2025 academic year

September 2024 start – born between 1st September 2020 to 31st August 2021. January 2025 start – born between 1st September 2021 to 31st December 2021

April 2025 start – born between 1st January 2022 and 31st March 2022
