It features the Diamond Rects® and Corner Beam® tools, as well as the Birds of Paradise Technique Sheet using the Large Square Squared® tool. These units beautifully combine to bring this pattern to life! I designed it to be a great companion to Block Party Block #35, and I've given you a unique layout idea below.

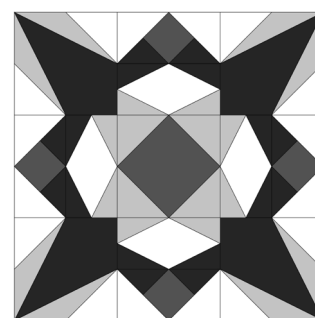
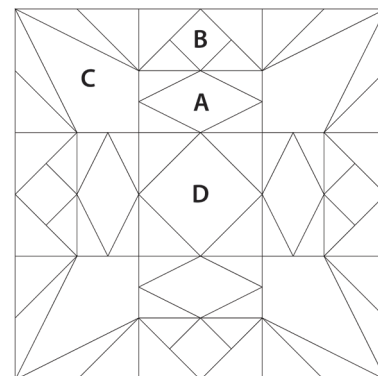

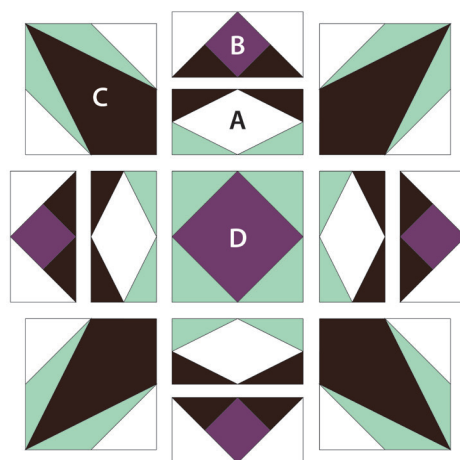

A: Diamond Rects 4 Units	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
B: Birds of Paradise 4 Units	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
C: Popped Corner Beam 4 Units	3" Finished 3 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 ½" cut sized	6" Finished 6 ½" cut sized
Corner Pop® I - Finished / Cut Away size on Corner Pop® I tool / Corner Trim Down Line			
	1 ½" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	2" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	3" Finished Size / Cut Away Size

Block Assembly

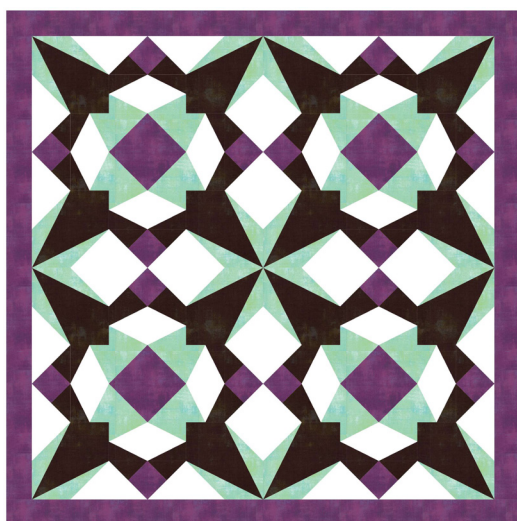
1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
3. Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.

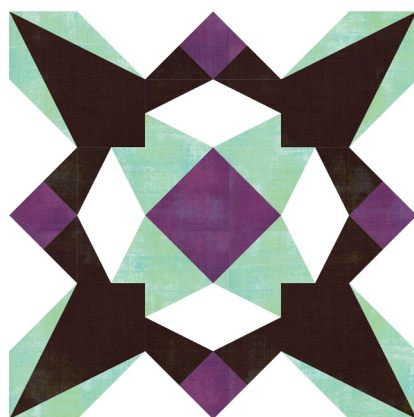
