Some object that the ultimate loss of even and single soul means the defeat of God's omnipotence. And so it does. In creating beings with free will, God from the outset submitted to the possibility of such defeat. But what you call "<u>defeat</u>," I call "<u>miracle</u>." For to make things which are not Itself, and thus <u>to become capable of being resisted</u> by Its own handiwork, <u>is the most astonishing and unimaginable of all the feats attributed to God</u>. I believe that the damned are, in one sense, <u>successful</u>, rebels to the <u>end</u>. In other words, the doors of Hell are locked on the <u>inside</u>. I do not mean that they lost may not <u>wish</u> to come out of Hell, in the vague fashion that an envious man "wishes" to be happy. But they certainly do not will even the first preliminary stages of self-abandonment <u>through which alone the soul can reach Heaven</u>. Tragically, they "enjoy" forever the <u>horrible freedom</u> they have <u>demanded</u>, and are therefore <u>self-enslaved</u>.

In the long run, the <u>answer</u> to all those who object to the doctrine of Hell is itself a <u>question</u>: "What are you asking God to do?" To wipe out their past sins and, at all cost, give them a fresh start, smoothing over every difficulty and offering every miraculous help? But He has done exactly that, on Calvary. To forgive them? They will not be forgiven. To leave them alone? Alas, I am afraid <u>that is what He does</u>. (*Problem of Pain*)

"In the end...there will only be two kinds of people: Those who say <u>to God</u>, 'Thy will be done,' and those to whom <u>God</u> says, '<u>Thy</u> will be done.'" (*Mere Christianity*)

Hell: Misunderstandings & Problematic Attitudes (The Judgments-Pt 4)

--Introduction:

- --<u>Matt 25:41, 46</u>: "Then He will also say to those on His left, 'Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the <u>eternal fire</u>...These will go away into <u>eternal punishment</u>..."
- --Rev 20:11, 12, 15: Then I saw a *great white throne* and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled...and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds...And if anyone's name was not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into *the lake of fire*.

--Some Pervasive Misunderstandings...and Problematic Attitudes about Eternal Punishment:

--<u>A historical fact</u>: <u>Errors</u> related to eternal punishment <u>ABOUND</u>...both in the <u>CHURCH</u>...and in the <u>WORLD</u>

--<u>Challenge #1</u>: To affirm God's <u>desire</u> to <u>SAVE</u> <u>everyone</u>...without <u>NEGATING</u> the clear biblical truth of the eternal <u>CONSEQUENCES</u> of unbelief

- --<u>Eternity Truth #1</u>: God <u>DESIRES</u> for <u>everyone</u> to have eternal life
 --<u>II Pet 3:9</u>: The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for <u>any</u> to perish but for <u>all</u> to come to repentance.
- --<u>Eternity Truth #2</u>: God has provided the <u>WAY</u> for <u>everyone</u> to have eternal life --<u>John 12:32</u>: And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, <u>will draw all</u> men to Myself."
- --Eternity Truth #3: MOST people will NOT have eternal life
 --Matt 7:13-14: Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it. For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.
- -- Eternity Truth #4: Eternal punishment will last FOREVER
 - --Mark 9:47-48: "And if your eye causes you to stumble, cast it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, than having two eyes, to be cast into hell, where their worm does not DIE, and the fire is not QUENCHED."
 - --<u>II Thess 1:7-9</u>: "... the Lord Jesus will be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels in flaming fire, dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. These will pay the penalty of <u>ETERNAL</u> destruction, away from the presence of the Lord..."
 - --What we learn from this verse:
 - Hell is <u>ETERNAL</u>
 - 2. Hell IS being AWAY from the Lord
 - --<u>A perfect contrast to the biblical doctrine of Heaven</u>: Eternal Paradise <u>IS</u> being... <u>WITH</u> the Lord

--Phil 1:20-23: "...according to my earnest expectation and hope, that I will not be put to shame in anything, but that with all boldness, Christ will even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life <u>or by death</u>. For to me, to live is Christ and <u>to die is gain</u>. But if I am to live on in the flesh, this will mean fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. But I am hard-pressed from both directions, having the desire to depart and be <u>with Christ</u>, for that is <u>very much better</u>..."

--<u>Eternity Truth #5</u>: The <u>SOULS</u> of unbelievers aren't <u>UNMADE</u> when they die --<u>The premise of "Annihilation Theology</u>": When a person dies...if they don't go to Heaven...then they simply <u>CEASE</u> to <u>EXIST</u>

--Rev 20:10: And the devil who deceived them was thrown into <u>the lake of fire</u> and brimstone, where the <u>beast</u> and the <u>false prophet</u> are also; and they <u>will</u> be tormented day and night <u>forever and ever</u>.

--Challenge #2: To affirm the clear biblical teachings about the reality of the coming <u>JUDGMENT</u>...without being <u>JUDGMENTAL</u>

--A truth about Hell that's very sobering: The most MERCIFUL Preacher of all time...preached about HELL...repeatedly

--<u>Matt 5:29-30</u>: If your right eye makes you stumble, <u>tear it out</u> and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body <u>to be thrown into hell</u>. If your right hand makes you stumble, <u>cut it off</u> and throw it from you; for it is better for you to lose one of the parts of your body, than for your whole body <u>to go into hell</u>.

--<u>Matt 10:28</u>: Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul; but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in <u>hell</u>.

-- Four HUGE warnings from Scripture:

--Warning #1: Judgment BEGINS in the HOUSEHOLD of God

--Warning #2: When John the Baptist and Jesus spoke about Hell...the VAST majority of the time...they were speaking to RELIGIOUS people!!!
--John the Baptist:

--Matt 3:7, 10, 11, 12: But when he saw many of the <u>Pharisees and Sadducees</u> coming for baptism, he said to <u>them</u>, "You brood of vipers, who warned you to flee from <u>the wrath to come?</u>...The axe is already laid at the root of the trees; therefore every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire...but He who is coming after me is mightier than I...and He will gather His wheat into the barn, but He will burn up the chaff with <u>unquenchable fire</u>."

--Jesus:

--<u>Matt 23:15</u>: "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you travel around on sea and land to make one proselyte; and when he becomes one, you make him <u>twice</u> as much a son of <u>hell</u> as <u>yourselves</u>."

--<u>Matt. 23:29, 33</u>: "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites...You serpents, you brood of vipers, how will you escape the sentence of *hell*?"

--<u>A great biblical irony</u>: Most <u>RELIGIOUS</u> people think of Hell as a place for <u>NON</u>-religious people

--Warning #3: Lots of <u>religious</u> people who are absolutely <u>CONVINCED</u> they're headed for Eternal Life... are completely <u>DECEIVED</u>!!!

--Matt 7:21-23: "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. Many will say to Me on that day, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?" And then I will declare to them, "I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness."

--Warning #4: Jesus' message was SCATHING to those who tried to determine who's "IN" and...who's "OUT"

--<u>Matt 7:1-3</u>: Do not judge so that you will not be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and <u>by your standard of measure</u>, it will be measured to you. Why do you look at the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice <u>the log</u> that is in <u>your own</u> eye?

-- Two pictures of judgment:

--The Samaritans:

--<u>Luke 9:51-54</u>: When the days were approaching for His ascension, He was determined to go to Jerusalem; and He sent messengers on ahead of Him, and they went and entered a village of the Samaritans to make arrangements for Him. But <u>they did not receive Him</u>, because He was traveling toward Jerusalem. When His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, <u>do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?"</u>

--<u>Luke 9:54-56</u>: When His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?" But He turned and <u>rebuked</u> them, and said, "You do not know <u>what kind of spirit you are of</u>; for the Son of Man <u>did not come to destroy men's lives</u>, <u>but to save them</u>."

--<u>An absolutely unwavering mission</u>: While it's all too easy for believers to focus on the wicked getting their <u>JUST</u> punishment...Jesus is <u>ALWAYS</u> focused on their <u>SALVATION</u>!!!

--Sodom:

--Gen 18:22-26: "... Abraham was still standing before the Lord. And Abraham came near and said, "Will You indeed sweep away the righteous with the wicked? <u>Suppose there are fifty righteous within the city; will You indeed sweep it away and not spare the place for the sake of the fifty righteous who are in it?</u> Far be it from You to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous and the wicked are treated alike. Far be it from You! Shall not the Judge of all the earth deal justly?" So the Lord said, "If I find in Sodom fifty righteous within the city, then I will spare the whole place on their account."
