




Cutting Instructions: Per Block


Units Name and # of Units	6″	12″	18″
A: Diamond Rects 4 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
B: Offset Four 4 Units	2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cut sized	6″ Finished 6 ½″ cut sized
C: Flying Geese 4 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
D: Square Squared 1 Units	2" Finished 2 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 ½" cut sized	6″ Finished 6 ½″ cut sized






Block Assembly

- 1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
 Make (1) Block.




