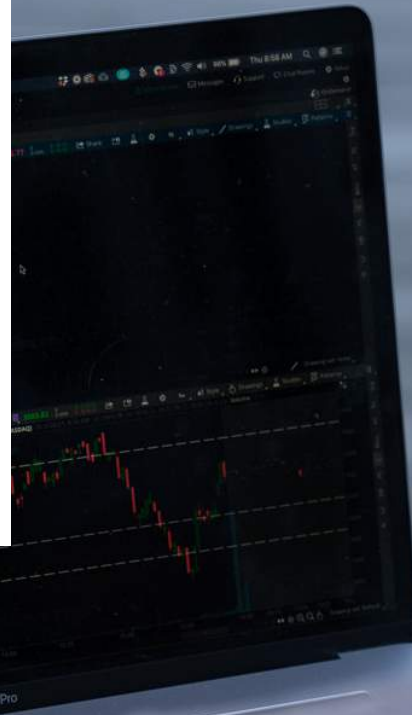

# A BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO HIGHSTRIKE SIGNALS GROUP



Welcome to the HighStrike Signals Group white paper. This document exists for the purpose of explaining the product's purpose, structure, features, and historical performance in great detail to help pragmatic prospective buyers understand the product's value and whether it's a good fit for them and something they want to invest in.

HighStrike Signals Group is operated by four experienced traders, our instructors, and is located on our private Discord server. Our instructors put out a watchlist of 4-8 stocks every morning, and call out live trades on these stocks and others throughout the day in the form of live voice alerts and messages. The alerts cover shares and options plays, including specifically targeted positions for small accounts less than \$1,000.

# HIGHSTRIKE SIGNALS MISSION STATEMENT, PURPOSE, AND GOALS



Our mission statement for HighStrike Signals is, “We aim to assist traders and investors of all experience levels, account sizes, trading styles, and risk appetites in making the best possible decisions for the growth of their portfolios through direct signaling of high-percentage shares and options positions every day. With our support channels, educational content, and community resources, we believe in the power of consistency and will continue to provide signals and strategies that fit a healthy and sustainable approach to trading and investing”.

One of our most important goals is to **provide consistent signals for all account sizes**. We have a dedicated channel called “small-account”, where we target shares and options plays for accounts with \$1,000 or less. Following our own guideline of a 10% portfolio allocation for allocation per options position, we make sure the options play we give for small accounts are less than \$100 in size. Larger accounts can also take these positions, as they’ll be able to buy more contracts or shares.

Another main goal of the signals group is to **provide education and theory behind following our signals plays**. This includes explaining terminology, configuring your workspace to optimize our resources in conjunction with your trading platform, and reviewing the analysis behind our signals plays so members can understand why the position was taken.

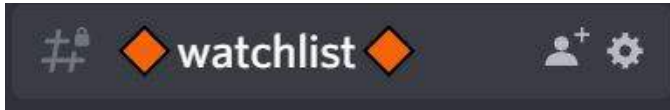

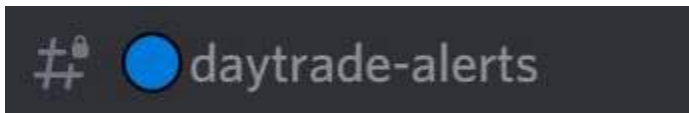
# STRUCTURES —AND— FEATURES

The signals group is located on our private Discord server. Discord is a powerful application that allows creators to share information and content in an organized way with members. In this section, we'll break down each channel and its purpose.

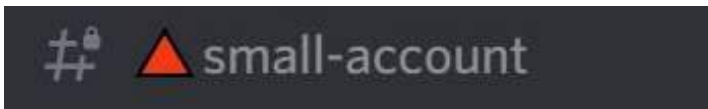
# Signals Group Channels Breakdown



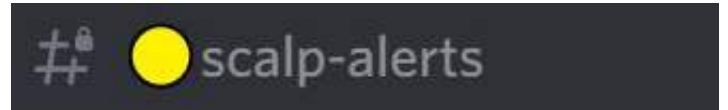
The **Watchlist** channel is where our team announces 4-8 stocks we are watching about 30 minutes before the market opens. We make sure to include at least one stock labeled **[SMALL ACCOUNTS]** for account sizes less than \$1,000 and individual positions less than \$100. In this watchlist announcement, we also note the options contracts we are looking to signal for each given stock. This list includes the exact entry point (where we are looking to buy) and price targets (where we are looking to sell). This channel is purely for the watchlist, and direct plays are given in their respective channels explained below.



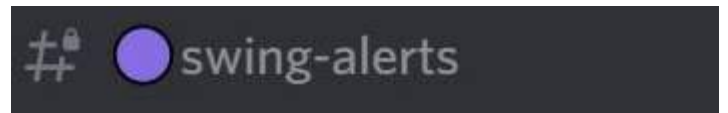
In the **daytrade-alerts** channel, our signalers are active throughout the day, giving entry and exit points for positions lasting between a few minutes and a few hours.



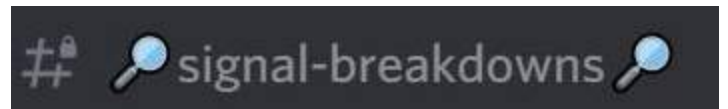
The **small-accounts** channel is where we give the watchlist for small accounts each morning, like a duplicate of their appearance in the main watchlist channel (above). We do this to ensure those with a small account have a dedicated channel they can check to get their watchlist for the day. Entries and exits for small account positions are given in the alerts channels as described above.



In the **scalp-alerts** channel, our signalers are very active in the first 30-60 minutes of the trading day. This channel is reserved only for alerts for entry and exit on scalp plays. Expect these positions to last for a few seconds to a few minutes.



We have reserved the **swing-alerts** channel for plays lasting over the course of multiple days or weeks. Our signalers are less active in this channel since swing plays last much longer, but updated analysis on open and prospective swing positions are consistently given in the Main Chat.

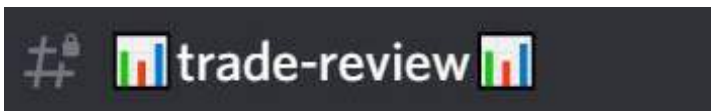


In the **signal-breakdown** channel, our instructors go over each signal that was given and discuss the analysis behind the signal. We do this to ensure that our members are not only taking our plays but that they are also understanding why the signals were given.

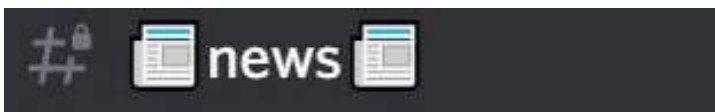
The **voice-alerts** channel is where everything above is communicated in audio form live. An instructor gives live voice signals in this channel for the first 30 minutes of every trading day.

# Signals Group Channels Breakdown

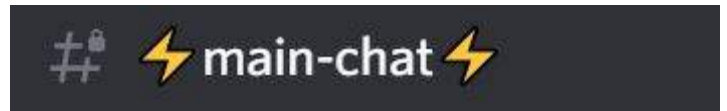
In addition to these instructors-only channels, the signals server includes several channels where members can actively participate in the discussion by asking questions, discussing ideas, providing feedback, and engaging as a community with a common goal. Here is a list of each of the members channels and their purpose.



In the **trade-review** channel, members are encouraged to break down the trades they make along with their analysis. These can be signals plays they followed or their own trades they took.



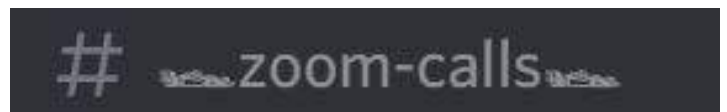
The **news** channel is reserved for sharing news articles, market information, price upgrades, and downgrades, and anything else that will help the group make better trading decisions.



The **main chat** is where most member discussion occurs. Members are free to discuss anything from positions they are considering to general strategy, trading setup, questions about positions and more.



The **loss-lessons** channel is reserved for members who wish to discuss any lessons they learned from losses incurred on their trades. Some choose to ask for feedback, others wish to share the lessons with the group in order to provide value to others.



The **zoom-calls** channel is where our instructors drop links to daily and weekly zoom calls. In these calls, our instructors review signals, offer explanations for entries and exits called, and look at upcoming opportunities. These calls are conducted live so members have a chance to ask questions.

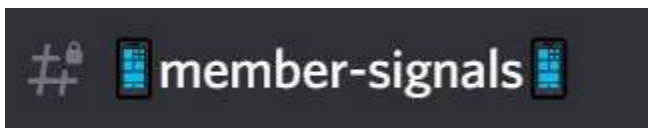
# Signals Group Channels Breakdown



Upon joining, the **videos** channel contains all resources members need to become acclimated to the group, understand where resources are located and learn how to process and implement signals.

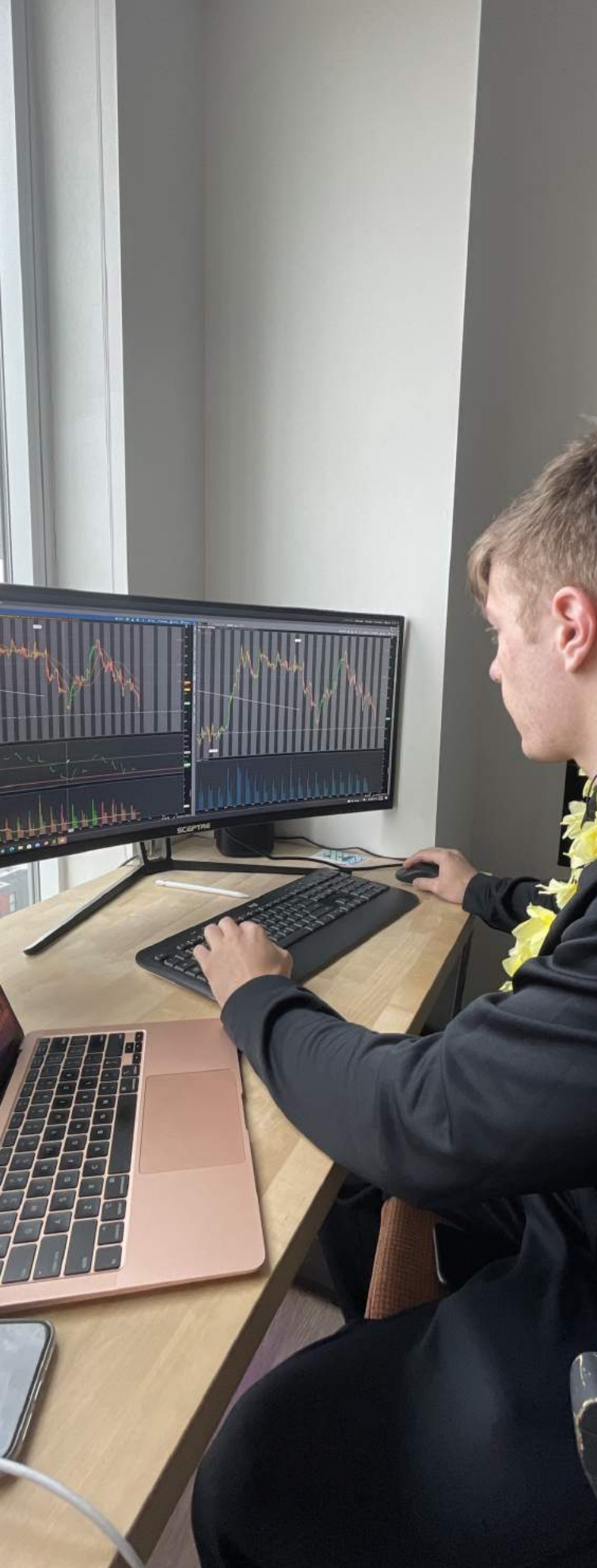


The **members-signals** channel is reserved for members who would like to offer their positions' entries and exits as they take them. Although our official signals are given in the channels noted on the previous page, this channel gives members the opportunity to offer their positions as well, although they are not HighStrike's official signals.



We thrive on feedback from our members in order to continuously improve our products. This **feedback** channel gives members a floor to suggest improvements and additions to the group as well as review their experience with the platform.
