#### THE POWER IN BAPTISM

### Titus 3:5-8

He saved us—not by righteous works that we did ourselves, but because of Hs mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and the renewal by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, <sup>7</sup> so that, having been justified by His grace, we might become heirs in keeping with the hope of eternal life. <sup>8</sup>This saying is trustworthy.

6. Baptism gets its power from the Gospel as the Holy Spirit offers the gifts of forgiveness, life, and salvation. How is this gospel working in your life? In our congregation?

## **NEW LIFE IN BAPTISM**

#### Romans 6:4

We were therefore buried with him by this baptism into his death, so that just as he was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too would also walk in a new life.

#### **Romans 4:25**
