Arden Farm Wildlife Network

The University is a member of the Arden Wildlife Network

and their project to increase tree sparrows, a threatened species. A wildflower area and winter bird seed mix has been sown at Wellesbourne and ten tree sparrow boxes installed. A volunteer undertook four bird surveys between February and March and saw 47 species; no tree sparrows have been recorded, however their return could take time. The following are just some of the species to be seen: Brambling, Corn Bunting, Fieldfare, Linnet, Redwing, and Yellowhammer.
