

## Mid-Year Election Changes – Prospectively revoking employer sponsored health coverage

Notice 2020-29 allows cafeteria plans to be amended to permit employees to make mid-year election changes. If the employer choses to amend their plan to participate in the permissible plan changes, the following is a sample attestation that may be used by an employee who is electing to drop coverage prospectively. Employers may rely on an employee's written attestation unless the employer has actual knowledge the employee is not, or will not be, enrolled in other comprehensive health coverage.

## **SAMPLE ATTESTATION**
