




Judy played for us on the pan pipe to show us how a sound is made on the Flute. Circle the tube in the picture below that will make the **lowest** sound. How do you know?



The tube on the right will make the lowest sound. It is the longest and largest, so it produces a lower pitch than the other tubes!



The Piccolo is the smallest Woodwind instrument! We can tell the difference between the three by size. The Piccolo is the smallest of the three, the Flute is the middle in size, and the Alto Flute is the largest of the three. Did you know there are Flutes larger than the Alto Flute as well?

How is a sound made on the Flute?

Flute players make a sound on the instrument by blowing air over the tone hole on the headjoint (the top part of the flute). Half of the air goes into the tube and half goes out into space!

What does the Flute sound like to you? How does that sound make you feel? Use the back of this sheet to write or draw what the sound of the Flute makes you think of!
