Chinggis Khaan International Airport (18 km to the southwest of Ulaanbaatar), is Mongolia's only international airport.



Best Time To Visit

September: the weather is pleasant and the beautiful landscape of Mongolia gleams with autumn colours. Nomads also have plenty of dairy products and are busy processing milk and preparing for winter.

June to September: Best season for Gobi Desert tour

July to August: Best season to travel to Northern Mongolia and Khuvsgul Lake tour.



Avoid Travelling On...

Winter in Mongolia lasts about four months, from November to February.

Temperatures are very low, and they can reach -40 ° C. The spring, lasting until end of May, is still cold and often windy or rainy.



Local Currency

Tugrik (symbol: MNT).

Hardly any bank outside of Mongolia will stock Tugrik bills or even coins, so you'll have to change your money after arrival. ATMs are widely available.

Credit cards are accepted in most hotels, restaurants and shops. Money changers are easily accessible and give better rates compared to hotels. US dollars are also accepted.



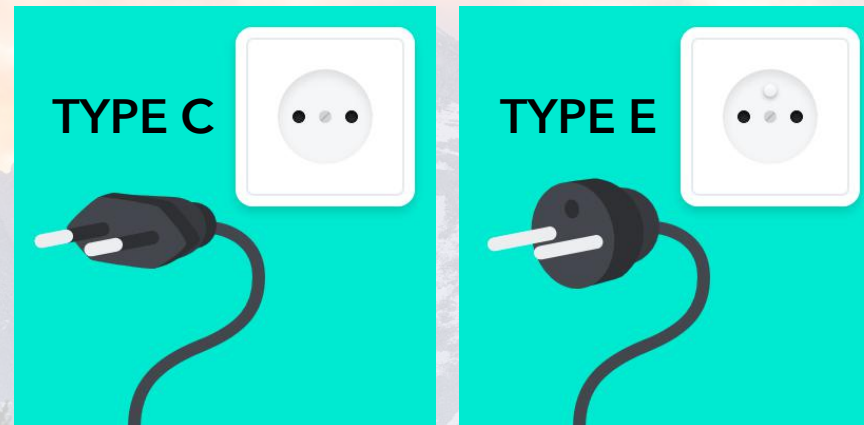

Naadam Festival

Mongolians are very passionate about the three “manly sports”: Mongolian Wrestling, Archery, and Horse Racing.
